ADMISSION OF NRI, FOREIGN NATIONALS (FN) AND PERSONS OF INDIAN ORIGINS (PIO) IN B. TECH. COURSES AT DTU FOR 2012-13

The admission to 5% seats in 15 B. Tech. full-time programs of Delhi Technological University (formerly Delhi College of Engineering) for NRIs, Foreign Nationals and Persons of Indian Origin shall be made on the basis of merit as per score in SAT-II (score with Physics and Mathematics level-II). The candidates must have a minimum of 60% marks in PCM in qualifying examination for admission to B. Tech Program.

1. NRIs.

An individual is Non-Resident when he is "not a resident" or who is "not ordinarily resident". A person is treated as "not ordinarily resident" when any of the following conditions is satisfied:

- 1. If he/she has not been resident in India in nine out of ten preceding years; or
- 2. If he/she has not been in India for a period of 730 days or more during the preceding seven years.

Only a person who is a NRI himself/herself may seek admission and no other candidate without NRI status would be eligible. Admission under this category shall be made on the basis of the merit as per score in SAT-II (scores with Physics and Mathematics level-II) for B. Tech. courses. Any seats remaining unfilled from the NRI quota will be filled from the applicants for admission under Foreign nationals/Persons of Indian Origin as per the merit of the candidates subject to their eligibility for admission to the University.

2. Persons of Indian Origin

"Persons of Indian Origin" (PIO) in this context means a person having foreign citizenship (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) without "NRI" status, but who holds a Foreign Passport at the time of sending application, consideration for admission and during the period of his study and he/she or anyone/ both of his/her parents or anyone/ both of his /her grandparents is (or was) / are (or were) citizen (s) of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Section 2 (b) of Citizenship Act, 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).

3. Foreign nationals

"Foreign National" (FN) in this context means an individual having citizenship of a foreign country (citizens of all countries other than India) and not having the status of "NRI" and/or "Persons of Indian Origin" (PIO).

The Foreign nationals or PIO nominated through/by Indian Council for Cultural Relation OR Government of India would be eligible.

Admission under these categories shall be made on the basis of the merit of the applicant as per score in SAT-II (scores with Physics and Mathematics level-II) for B. Tech. programs subject to their eligibility for admission to the University.

Eligibility: The candidates besides securing 60 percent or more marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics should have also secure a minimum of 50% SAT-II (Maths- level-II and Physics) score shall be eligible for admission to the first semester of Bachelor of Technology (B. Tech) Courses provided he/she passed in each subject separately. Only those Non Resident Indians/PIO students who have studied from schools or colleges in foreign countries and passed the qualifying examinations i.e. second year Pre-university or XII standard or equivalent examination from a recognized university/Board will be eligible. This will include the students studying in the schools or colleges situated in foreign countries even if affiliated to the Board of Secondary Education or Universities located in India, but will not include students studying in those schools or colleges (situated in India) and affiliated to the Boards of Secondary Education, or Universities of the foreign countries. Students passing the qualifying examination from Boards or universities located in foreign countries as external students

and dependent of NRIs studying in India will not be included. In case of Foreign Nationals candidates, who have passed qualifying examination from any country including INDIA, shall be eligible for admission.

Age Requirements: Applicant must be 17 years of age on or before the first October, 2012. Relaxation in minimum age in exceptionally meritorious cases may be granted with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor. (Such Candidate should apply for relaxation at the time of submission of the application for admission).

Admission Procedure: Admission to B. Tech programs for NRI/PIO/Foreign National will be strictly on the basis of SAT-II (Maths-level-II and Physics) Score. Candidate are required to apply online through DTU admission website www.dtuadmissions.nic.in. Please refer counseling schedule and all related information available on this web site.

Medium of Instructions: Medium of Instructions is English in this University.

Fees:

- 1. US\$ 7000 (US Dollars Seven Thousand) annually for students of NRI/FN/PIO.
- 2. US\$ 5000 (US Dollars Five Thousand) annually for Foreign Nationals who are nationals of SAARC countries.
- 3. US\$ 5000 (US Dollars Five Thousand) annually for candidates from Nepal and Bhutan.
