Creative Ability Test Undergraduate (fashion design and accessory design)

Time allowed: 3 hours

Instructions: This test is administered to judge the skill, power of observation, innovation and design ability of the candidate. An important aspect of the test is the candidate's use of color and illustration.

- 1. All questions carry equal marks. There are 3 questions.
- 2. The aim of the test is to investigate the following abilities required to pursue a design course.
 - Observation power
 - An appreciation of form, color, shapes.
 - Verbal as well as non -verbal communication skills.
 - Innovative ways to look at and describe objects and environment.
 - Imaginative expression
- Q.1. Sketch a peacock in dancing form in a forest area. (Credit will be given for sketches with innovative expression of the subject matter)
- Q.2. Using few traditional Indian motifs, design a scarf (the sketch should be of 20 cm x 16 cm)
- Q.3. Draw an under water coral reef with fish and marine life.
