INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES
(To be retained by the candidate)

1. The written examination will be held in August 201.....
 2. The last date for receipt of filled-in application together with the prescribed fee in the form of D.D. drawn in favour of **The Registrar, University of Madras, Chennai - 600 005**, is 30th May 201.....
 3. The fee prescribed in as follows:

Part - I : Theory Papers (Consisting of three papers)	Rs. 200/ (each)
Part - II : Dissertation	Rs. Full Time Rs. 1,000/- Part Time Rs. 1,500/-
 4. In addition to the prescribed fee, candidates should also pay Rs. ~~25/-~~^{100/-} towards the fee for the issue of Statement of Marks and Rs. 25/- being the cost of application form.
 5. Late applications will be accepted after the due date specified above upto 10 days only on payment of penalty fee of Rs.100/-
 6. a) The Full-Time candidates are required to remit Rs.100/- towards the issue of Provisional Certificate and Rs. 150/- towards the Convocation fee for In-absentia along with the examination fee.
b) The Part-Time candidates are required to remit the above Provisional Certificate fee & Convocation fee at the end of second year.
- The fee once paid will not be refunded or carried over for the subsequent examination under any circumstances**
7. The fee should be remitted in the form of D.D. drawn in favour of the Registrar, University of Madras.
 8. Arrear candidates should also forward their applications through the Head of the University Department / Principal of the College only.
 9. Candidates should obtain the Hall-tickets from the Head of the University Department / Principal of the College concerned where they underwent the course three days before the commencement of the examination.
 10. The results will be sent to the University Dept. / College / Institutions where the candidates underwent the Course
 11. The Examination Centre will be notified to the respective University Dept. / College / Institution.
 12. All Candidates admitted during 201....- 201.... should get themselves registered for the course immediately, otherwise they will not be permitted to appear for the examination.
 13. The candidates should not change the guide assigned to them without obtaining prior approval of the University. Such approval should be obtained atleast a month before the last date prescribed for submission of dissertation.
 14. The candidates should not change the title of the dissertation furnished in column 8 of the examination application at a later date under any circumstances.
 15. The supervisor / guide should certify in each dissertation submitted, that it is a bonafide record of work done by the candidate (from.....to) that the dissertation has not formed the basis for award of any other Degrees, Diploma, Associateship, Fellowship or other similar title; and that the dissertation represents independent work on the part of the candidate under his / her guidance.
 16. The last date prescribed for submission of examination application for (duly filled in) should be strictly adhered to and no delay will be condoned in this regard under any circumstances.
