I. Objectives Of OMAT - Note to colleges

OVERSEAS MEDICAL ADMISSION TEST 2014. FOR OVERSEAS UNIVERSITIES.

1.1 Overseas Medical Admission Test: 13th July 2014

The Overseas Medical Admission Test (OMAT) is a medical college entrance examination conducted in India, Bangladesh and Nepal for the students wishing to take admission in Medical Universities abroad leading to an MBBS /MD degree. Although it shall initially be conducted in these countries it may later be extended to other countries as well.

I.2 Objective

The objective to conduct the exam is to improve the quality of students securing admission in universities abroad. The percentile results of the students shall be shared with the participating universities enabling the universities to select the students most suitable for their colleges. The universities shall be free to offer "admission offer "letters to the students and it shall be the students prerogative to select a college from among the offer letters based on factors such as location, fees, scholarship availability, distance from native place etc.

1.3 Expected Participation

The total number of students expected to participate is in the region of 20,000 – 30,000. This estimate is based on the total numbers of students going abroad for higher studies. The actual numbers of participants may vary from the estimates.

I.4 Legal

The admission test will be conducted in a free, fair and impartial manner. The integrity of the test is of paramount importance to the governing body and no effort shall be spared to ensure this objective. The test is governed by a committee comprising of 7 members.

5 members of this committee shall be executive members drawn from academic circles.

The appellate committee shall consist of 3 members, one each from the judiciary, academia and administration

The appellate committee shall be the committee of appeal for all grievances and shall also give directions and advice on the conduction of the exam whenever required.

The committee shall ensure that the exam remains sacrosanct in all locations where it shall be conducted.

The details of the membership of the appellate and executive committee are available on the website www.omat.in

1.5 Logistics

The Exam shall be conducted in 22 locations across India. 1 location in Nepal and 1 Location in Bangladesh (For a list of locations please refer website)

The exam shall be a pen and paper test and the OMR sheet with the answers shall be available for scrutiny if required by the colleges. The exam shall be conducted in a classroom commandeered for the purpose and shall have adequate security. The examination paper shall be handed over to the head of examinations in that particular location one hour before the start of examination in a sealed condition. The seal shall be broken in the presence of the invigilators deputed in each centre / location.

The curriculum on which the test shall be based are the Higher Secondary or School leaving examinations i.e. Class XII as in the Indian subcontinent, A levels as in the International Baccalaureate or Cambridge exams. The examination shall be conducted on Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

1.6 Participating Universities

The colleges enlisted with (list available on website) OMAT are all authorised to conduct the medical program in their university and authorised by the legal & statutory authority governing admissions. The list is regularly updated and students/stakeholders are advised to check the website for recent inclusions.

2. Rules & Regulations Governing the OMAT

2.1 Eligibility criteria for the students to appear OMAT

- Candidates must have either passed or appeared the qualifying Higher Secondary or equivalent examination of that particular country of which they are resident.
- The scores of OMAT are valid in tandem with the eligibility requirements of the concerned universities.

2.2 How to Apply OMAT

Instructions For Completing The On-Line Application

- 1. The application is available online at www.omat.in
- 2. The application form is to be filled online in a proper manner, following all the instructions and without making any mistakes in the form.
- 3. Red highlighted fields are mandatory and must be filled in.
- **4.** An email confirming the registration will be sent with an assigned Application number and a password. The application number and the password are required for subsequent operations. Hence the candidate should remember them or keep them in safe place.
- 5. Candidates must upload their recent passport size photograph in the field for candidate photo. Please ensure that the photo should be in jpeg/jpg format with a resolution of 110 X 140 pixels
- 6. Candidate must upload their complete signature on the application form at the specified place.
- 7. Candidate must upload their matriculation certificate / Class X / O level transcript at the specified place.
- 8. Online application can be completed in one or more sessions by revisiting the website using the assigned application number and password.
- 9. The candidate can edit data in any field till the final submission and printout is taken. The last date for on-line submission of application is July 2nd 2014.
- 10. Kindly keep your demand draft ready before entering the payment details. Once the payment details are filled in correctly you can submit the application. Please take a printout of the application form for your ready reference.

2.3 Last date for submission of application & fee for OMAT

Saraswati Online.Com India Ltd has notified the last date for submission of application form and fee for appearing in OMAT for academic session 2014-2015 as **02nd July 2014**.

2.4 Fee & Application details

An application fee of Rs.2000 shall be made in the prescribed format and is payable by Demand draft/ Bankers Cheque, payable at Bangalore in the name of **Saraswati Online.Com India Ltd - A/C OMAT.**

You are required to send the Demand draft to the below address by registered post. At the back of the draft please write your Name & Application number clearly before you send it.

2.5 Appearing in OMAT

On receipt of your application form duly filled in and clearance of your payment you shall be intimated by email/SMS in the registered email id and mobile number as listed in your application form. You may then download the Admit Card which has your unique identification number and shall be quoted for all future correspondences.

On the date of the examination you are required to carry this admit card as well as any other valid photo ID card to the examination center.

3. General Instructions to Candidates

- a. Report 60 minutes before the commencement of the test.
- b. The Examination Hall will be opened 30 minutes before the commencement of the test. Candidates are expected to take their seats immediately. If the candidates do not report in time, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions.
- Che candidate must show, on demand, admit card for admission in the Examination Hall. A candidate who does not possess valid Admit Card of OMAT and valid photo identity card shall not be allowed to write the Entrance Test. It is mandatory for the candidate to bring his/her recent photo not older than 6 months. At the back of the photo please write the Admit Card number.
- d. In the examination Hall the candidate must find / occupy his/her specific place checking the Admit card number pasted on the desk. If a candidate is found writing the test from a place which is not assigned to him / her , his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- e. Test commences at 11:00 AM
- f. Fifteen minutes after the commencement of the test, no candidates will be allowed to enter the examination hall to take the test.
- g. OMAT is not responsible for any delay by any means of transportation to the city and reaching the test centre beyond the given time. For outstation candidates it is advisable to reach the Test Location a day prior to the examination.
- h. Candidates are advised in their own interest not to carry any of the personal computational devices, Blue-tooth devices, cell phones, any electronic gadgets etc; to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping of the same cannot be assured.
- i. Candidates must not carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers, any electronic gadgets except the admit card and a blue/black ball-point pen inside the Examination hall.
- j. For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date of the examination for any reason, re-examination shall not be held by OMAT under any circumstances.

3. I OMR Answer sheet

All answers need to be registered on an Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet, which is machine read and evaluated. **Candidates must use only black or blue ballpoint pen** for marking their answers on the OMR Answer sheet. Use of pencils or erasers or whiteners is not permitted.

- a. OMR answer sheets will be supplied only at the examination hall. After the test is over, the answer sheet should be given back, before leaving the room. Candidates are allowed to take the question booklet only on completion of the test duration time.
- b. Kindly note that the candidates must sign their OMR answer sheets in the presence of the invigilator. Invigilators will also sign on the column indicating Invigilators Signature on the OMR Answer Sheet otherwise the answer sheet will be invalid and not be considered for processing.
- c. The OMR Answer sheet contains the following fields which have to be filled in neatly and accurately by the candidate with blue/black ball point pen only. Use of pencil on the OMR answer sheet is not allowed. OMR answer sheet filled in with pencil would be rejected for evaluation.



- d. The OMR answer sheet is machine assessed and therefore it should be handled with care. If there is any doubt, please contact the test invigilator immediately.
- e. The OMAT -2014 test administration is timed. The test session is designed to be completed within the specified time as indicated in the brochure and no compromise will be made on the set time limits. The Chief Superintendent of the test centre is the official timekeeper. Candidates (Test Takers) will not be permitted to continue the test beyond the established time limit.
- f. Candidates are not allowed to go out of the room temporarily for any reason during the test duration.



3.2 Note to Parents / Guardians

Parents/Guardians are advised to ensure that their ward should not indulge in unfair means activities/malpractices which breach the examination rules. If any candidate is found to be indulging in any such activity he/she shall be debarred from taking this examination permanently in future and shall also be liable for criminal action and/or any other action deemed fit by the governing body.

3.3 Grounds for Dismissal

The OMAT - 2014 test administrator is authorised to dismiss a candidate from a test session for:

- **a.** Attempting to take the test for someone else (Impersonation).
- b. Failing to provide acceptable identification proof when asked for.
- c. Creating disturbance at the test venue.
- d. Giving or receiving unauthorised help.
- e. Using any forbidden / unauthorised testing aids, such as personal computational devices, blue-tooth devices, cell phones, any electronic gadgets etc.,
- f. Leaving the test centre before the stipulated time.
- g. Refusing to follow directions as stipulated by the invigilators etc.,
- h. If the candidate has a past history of criminal records or has been involved in ragging as defined by the concerned Regulatory Authorities, he will not allowed to take the entrance test.
- i. The UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions issued in April 2009 is available on the UGC website separately
- j. Requests for use of toilet during the test are not entertained.
- **k.** Failure to comply with the test procedures and regulations or with the test administrator's directions can result in OMAT taking action/s that include, but are not limited to, barring candidates from future testing and or canceling the test scores. No results would be announced in respect of dismissed candidates.

3.4 Result Publishing

- Provisional Answer Keys of OMAT -2014 will be published on the website late in the evening of the next day.
- Clarifications to the provisional answer keys, if any, should be sought between 14th and 15th of July 2014.

(Communications received after 15th July, 5 PM will not be entertained).

- Final Answer Keys will be published on 17th July 2014.
- Merit list of OMAT -2014 will be published on 18th July 2014.

3.5 Applicants seeking any clarifications with regard to Provisional Answer Keys

- a. Should write to OMAT, clearly indicating the grievance and with all necessary enclosures in a prescribed format which can be downloaded from our website.
- b. Clarification regarding provisional answer key should reach the OMAT office by speed post / courier along with a Demand Draft of Rs 200 (Rupees Two Hundred) per clarification, drawn in favour of 'Saraswati Online.Com India Limited A/C OMAT', payable at Bangalore.
- C. Only if the clarification sought is upheld, the money would be refunded in total after the OMAT 2014 process is completed.
- d. Any request for clarification of provisional answer keys beyond the last date as stipulated in calendar of events will not be entertained.
 - **Note:** Seeking clarification as above is only for provisional answer keys. Such clarifications are not entertained in respect of Final Answer Keys and subsequent Final Scores.
- e. Any verifications / clarifications sought by the applicants will be put forth to the OMAT's Academic Committee for their consideration and the decision given by the committee shall be final and binding on all. No further claims will be considered by OMAT after the last date, as indicated above.

3.6 Test Scores

- a. The final test scores of the candidates shall be put up on the website against their Admit Card number.
- b. The percentile secured by the candidate shall also be displayed.
- C. The percentile score is calculated as the number of people who got less than or equal to you / number of people who appeared on the test X 100
 - e.g.: If 10 people appeared for the test and 5 people got less than or equal to you then the scores will read as $5/10 \times 100 = 50$ percentile.
- e. This is a scoring pattern used to measure relative competence. Hence it will indicate how well you scored compared to others but will not indicate how high you scored in any particular subject.
- f. The test results and the OMR sheets will be made available to the colleges enlisted with OMAT who shall then be free to send offer letters to the applicants as per their eligibility norms.
- g. If a candidate receives more than one offer letter, he / she is free to choose any one of the colleges offering him/her a position.

All candidates must note that any form of canvassing or influence exercised would result in permanent disqualification of the application without any prior notice to the applicant. www.omat.in is the only official website and OMAT governing board is not responsible for information available on other websites / elsewhere.

3.7 Criteria for Rejection of your Application For OMAT

Applications would be rejected without notice if

- a. Incomplete application form.
- b. No recent passport size color photograph uploaded in the online application form. (Xerox photos / black and white photos are not acceptable)
- c. No candidate's signature uploaded.
- d. Demand Draft does not have bankers signature
- e. Demand Draft not in favour of "Saraswati Online.Com India Limited A/C OMAT"
- f. Demand Draft not payable at "Bangalore".
- a. Demand Draft sent with lesser amount than the required amount.
- h. Demand draft is Mutilated.
- i. No Demand Draft received.

3.8 Change Request

Candidates are cautioned to fill up the online application form carefully as the request for change in any application data entered and submitted online will not be entertained.

3.9 Change in venue

No change in venue shall be entertained after 02nd July 2014.

3.10 Pattern of OMAT 2014

- Pattern of the Entrance Test: The Entrance Test shall consist of a single paper containing 200 objective type questions (four options with single correct answer) from Physics, Chemistry Biology (Botany & Zoology) and English to be answered on the specially designed machine-gradable sheet using Ball Point Pen only. The duration of the test shall be of 3 hours from 11AM to 2 PM only.
- Both the subjects Physics and Chemistry shall contain 10 questions based on mathematical calculations. Each correct answer shall be awarded one mark. No marks will be awarded for multiple marking(marking multiple responses) of any question.
- There will be no negative marking.
- In the event of a tie in the test score the principle of least negative responses (No. of wrong answers will be adopted). In addition other methods may be adopted to break ties.
- Language of the Question Papers: Question paper shall be in English only
- OMAT 2014 will be conducted on Sunday the 13th July 2014 from 11:00 am to 002:00 PM. The schedule will remain unaltered even if the
 above date is declared a public holiday.

3.1 I Syllabus For The Test

The questions for the exam shall be based on the Higher Secondary or equivalent board syllabus. Please login to www.omat.in for details.

3.12 Centres For Entrance Test

List of cities where the OMAT - 2014 will be conducted is given in the website www.omat.in

- The candidate should select two convenient city codes for the entrance test from annexure 1 available on the website.
- Though every effort will be made to allot a centre in one of the places selected by the candidate, yet the Board reserves its discretion to allot a centre other than the candidate's choice.
- In the event that the choice of centre made by the candidate has less than 25 applicants the candidate shall be allotted the next nearest centre where the candidate strength is more than 25.
- In the event of a change of centre the candidate shall be informed latest by 3rd July 2014.

Nanfang Medical University, located at the foot of the Baiyun mountains in Guangzhou city is a comprehensive medical university. Earlier known as First Military Medical University it was later renamed as Nanfang Medical University or Southern Medical University.

It is listed with the World Health Organisation, IMED, MCI and other medical directories.

Southern Medical University has established a complete system for nurturing talented candidates of Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery(MBBS), Bachelors Degree of Medicine (MB.), Masters Degree of Medicine (MM.) and Doctoral Degree of Medicine (MD.), with eight academic fields covering medicine, technology, science, law, management, arts, pedagogy and economics.

The university has 2 affiliated hospitals Nanfang Hospital with over 2500 patient beds and Zhejiang Hospital with about 1000 hospital beds. These hospitals specialize in diagnosis and treatment with endoscopy, cardiovascular intervention, haematodialysis, organ transplantation, cryotherapy among others. In addition it also has a 400 bedded Overseas Hospital catering to international patients.

The faculty strength comprises more than 2000 including among them 200 full or associate professors apart from 1 one academician of Chinese Science Academy, one academician of Chinese Engineering Academy, more than 80 supervisors of Ph. D candidates and 200 supervisors of master degree candidates. Many of the professors have won National & International accolades for academic brilliance and are also on the boards of universities outside China.

The University has undertaken more than 400 key projects of WHO, the State, Army and for Guangdong province and has also made commendable contributions in clinical anatomy, study of tears, viral hepatitis, free radical medicine, prevention & treatment of battlefield traumatic shock etc.









Nanfang University also has cooperative research and academic exchanges with the US, Britain, Japan, France Australia and Hong Kong.

From 1996-2003 (since the Ninth Five-year Project), the university won 9 second prizes of State Scientific and Technological Advances Award, accounting for half of the total 19 second prizes which all the universities and institutes in Guangdong Province gained during that period (no first-grade prize was awarded). During the period of "Tenth Five-year Project", the university won 9 first-grade prizes of Guangdong Scientific and Technological Advances Awards appraised among the provincial field of medicine and hygiene, accounting for 53% of the total 17 first-grade prizes awarded at the provincial level.

In 1985, Nanfang Hospital of the university purchased the MRI, the first one then in China. Then they compiled and published a book on MRI, regulating the first diagnosis standard on MRI. The imaging center is the distance consultation center for tens of small- and middle-scope hospitals in Guangdong Province and the university has held the position of chief editor in compiling Medical Imageology.

In 1997, the university purchased 3-dimensional conformal radiotherapy system, the first system in South China. It has been used to treat 3,000 patients, the largest number in South China.

In 1999, the university purchased PET, the first set in Guangdong Province, developed and manufactured PET developing agent themselves. They have used it to examine 7,300 patients, which is the largest number in China.

In 1999, the university introduced Argan-Heliurn Surgery System, the first one in Asia.

In 2002, the university introduced Photo-dynamic Therapy (PDT), which has been used to treat over 200 patients, the largest number in China

The university has more than 800 students from India and has recorded 436 graduates who have successfully cleared the Foreign Medical Graduates examination conducted by the National Board of Examinations India and are now registered health practitioners. Many of the students are still pursuing their studies on campus.

The university is ranked in the top among the medical universities and colleges in China in view of the number of research projects and the prizes. From 2001 to 2003 during the Tenth Five-year Project in China, the faculties of the university undertook 643 programs funded by the Central Government, Guangdong Provincial and Guangzhou Municipal governments, with a total amount of 138 million yuan, and thus was ranked at the first place among the medical universities in Guangdong Province.

Jinan University (JNU) is a public research and comprehensive university based in Guangzhou, Guangdong province, China. It is one of the oldest universities established on mainland China tracing back to the Qing Empire.

It is one the 211 national key universities and is currently the Chinese university with the largest number of international students. In fact Jinan has several firsts to its credit

- The first university in China to recruit foreign students
- •The first university in China to enroll students in both spring and autumn semesters
- The first university that pioneered the implementation of credit system in China
- The university with the largest number of overseas students
- The only university which have alumni in both Chinese and foreign state-level leaders in China

The college is regulated by the Central Government of PR China and enjoys state support as well as grants from munificient benefactors.

The College was conferred as the "National Base of Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language" by The Education Ministry, and "Overseas Chinese Education Base" by Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council.

A comprehensive multi disciplinary university, it has 25 colleges, comprising 55 departments and offering 86 undergraduate majors. Among the 55 departments, 43 offer master degree programs and 19 departments offer Ph.D degree granting programs. There are 15 post doctoral research stations, 170 research institutes and 84 labs in Jinan University.







The medical college of Jinan University was set up in 1978 along with a modern hospital known as Guangzhou Chinese Overseas Hospital. The college has set up 12 labs with an estimated 8.5 million RMB in medical equipment.

The First Affiliated Hospital of Jinan University, also known as the Guangzhou Overseas Chinese Hospital, is one of the leading hospital which integrates medical treatment, teaching, scientific research, prophylaxis, health care and healing services. The hospital is located inside the campus of Jinan University with the area over 50,000 square meters and with over 800 professionals employed. The hospital has comprehensive ties with many countries and regions, including America, Australia, Canada, Japan, Britain, Hong Kong, Macao etc. The hospital is now preparing to construct an international clinic.

Dali University is a multi disciplinary university spread over 3 campuses, the South Renmin Road campus, Hehua campus and ancient town campus all located within the city of Dali situated in Yunnan province. Dali is 5 hours by road and 6 hours by rail from Kunming which is the provincial capital and connected internationally by airlines of most countries.

Dali is considered as one of the most beautiful cities In China and the university has fostered over the past decades a large number of qualified graduates for various disciplines including that of clinical medicine staffing hospitals, medical health organisations, schools of different kinds.

The university attaches great importance to scientific research and has undertaken more than 171 scientific research programs including 9 national level and provincial level programs winning the provincial science award. It employs 971 full-time teachers, 122 professors, 287 associate professors. It has completed many international research projects, national and provincial level research projects. The two most import-



ant projects are "the Control and Management of Polluted Water Bodies" and "the Prevention and Control of AIDS and Viral Hepatitis". As of 2013, the University has 71 China invention patents, published 115 Monographs and teaching materials and more than 2000 papers, which included 146 in SCI and EI.

With state of the art classrooms and hospital Dali University has had a wide ranging influence on the study of medicine in South East China. Dali Hospital has 500 patient beds and occupies 8.6 hectares. There are 560 staff in the hospital. With advanced medical equipment and the establishment of the university's tele medicine centre in 2006 new and complicated surgeries such as In vitro fertilisation, bone screw treatment of spinal fractures, total hip replacement and neuroma ectomy in cere bellopontine angle are being done.







Dali University is an international university that enjoys a high reputation in Southeast Asia and in fact throughout South Asia. As of 2013, more than 5000 international students graduated from Dali University. They were from 42 countries and regions, including Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Nepal, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, USA and South Korea. Presently there are 759 full-time international students. The University has established many exchange and cooperation projects and academic research working with more than 40 foreign universities.

Luzhou Medical College was founded in the year 1951 and since then has had 50 glorious years in the service of the nation. It is one of the foremost schools of higher learning in Sichuan province. Situated in the city of Luzhou, the college has 2 campuses Zhongshan campus and Nangao campus separated by the Tuo river.

The college has trained 20,000 students, and has evolved into a large-scale college of teaching, medical care and scientific research. It is characterized for combining Traditional Chinese Medicine with Western Medicine in various ways and at different levels.

Luzhou Medical College has 16 departments. It has 18 majors and 9 special directions, among which there are 8 key provincial majors, 2 provincial key institutes, 2 provincial bases and 17 provincial key courses.

There is also a nursing school, a pharmaceutical factory, 7 non-subordinating hospitals and 56 teaching hospitals which total 20,000 clinical beds. The Affiliated Hospital of LZMC is a "National Class A-Grade tertiary care hospital", and is one of the biggest and most advanced hospitals in Southwest China. It has 1,500 staff (300 are professors and associate professors) and 60 departments with 6447 clinical beds. The successful separating operation performed on a pair of Siamese twins in 2004 was the 1st case done in Sichuan.

The college now has 13 provincial and national research institutes including the Vascular Medicine Institute, 4 provincial key specialties and 17 provincial key courses. "The Journal of Luzhou Medical College" is published both in China and abroad, and has an international CO-DEN code for document retrieval. Furthermore, it is certified by the State Science Ministry as one of the resource journals for natural science information statistics. Since 1993 the college has carried out 625 research programs, more than 1/4 of which have won awards of the ministry, the province and the city, and 12 were patented. 4,872 research papers have been published in various journals both nationally and abroad.

The college has established international exchange and cooperation relationship with 26 universities and institutes in 9 countries including Japan, Germany and the U.S.A. The college employs long-term foreign teachers to teach English language and medical subjects, and invites short-term visiting scholars to give guest lectures.
