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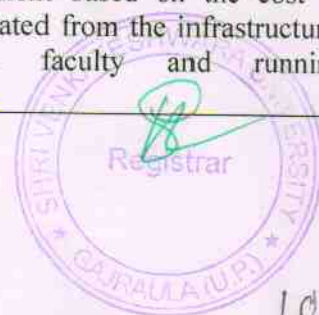

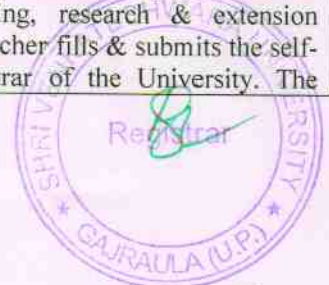

Being in rural area the availability of electricity is a major problem with the University.
