

Date of Commencement

The Test Series will commence from **10th October, 2010* (Sunday)**

*Two online practice tests on AIPMT Pattern will be made available from **12th September, 2010** for students to get accustomed to the AIATS level.

Eligibility

A student who is studying in class XI or have passed class X is eligible to join All India Aakash Test Series for Medical - 2012.

Criteria of Admission

A student must have secured minimum 55% marks in Science & Maths in class X to join All India Aakash Test Series for Medical - 2012.

The photocopy of marksheet (attested by the student himself or herself) should be attached with the Admission Form.

Mode of Test

Offline: To be given at the test centres at the cities listed on Page No. 12.

Online: On computer with internet connection from home or any internet cafe.

Number of Tests

In the first year, 10 tests will be conducted, covering the class XI syllabus. In next year, 20 tests will be conducted, covering entire course of class XI again & class XII syllabus.

Medium of Test

The medium of test is English & Hindi.

Submission of Admission Form

The last date of submission of admission form is:

1st October, 2010 by post and **8th October, 2010** personally at the counter of DLP Office.

Fee

The total fee for this course is **Rs. 8500/-** (Rs. 7,706/- + 10.3% service tax Rs. 794/-).

Fee Timings: 10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Mode of Payment

Cash at counter / DD in favour of '**Aakash Institute**' payable at **New Delhi**.

Note: We will provide 4 online practice tests, 2 in Year-1 & 2 in Year-2 before commencement of All India Aakash Test Series in each year for both offline & online students.

Concession Criteria

50%	will be given to those students who have secured 100% marks in class X Board in Maths and/or Science
35%	Topper of any State Board or CBSE Board Exam. OR NTSE Scholars / Olympiad Scholars (below 100 Ranks) or Grade Point 10 in both Science & Maths in Class X.
25%	A1 Grade in both Science & Maths in Class X OR 95% and above in Science & Maths in Class X OR 90% and above aggregate in Class X board exam. OR 89% and above in PCB in Class XII board exam. OR students who have qualified CBSE Prelim. Exam. 2010 OR Ex-Aakashian who has already taken our classroom coaching for one year course or two years course at any Centre / Branch of Aakash Institute.
15%	A1 Grade in Science & A2 Grade in Maths or vice versa in Class X OR between 90% & 94.5% in Science & Maths in Class X board exam. OR Between 85% & 88.5% in PCB in Class XII board exam.
10%	A2 Grade in Science & Maths in class X OR between 85% & 89.5% in Science & Maths in Class X board exam. OR Between 80% & 84.5% in PCB in Class XII board exam.
5%	Between 80% & 84.5% in Science & Maths in Class X board exam.

NOTE: 1. A student can avail one of the above merit scholarship whichever is higher.
2. 10% relaxation in marks for WB, Orissa, Jharkhand, Bihar, UP, UT, HR, North-East District Boards etc. students for merit scholarships.

Pattern of Test

AIPMT 2011: The All India Aakash Test Series for Medical comprises of 20 tests with an option of online/offline (at the test centre) mode which prepares the students for AIPMT and other Medical Entrance Exams. These tests have been prepared by our expert faculty which has not only produced excellent results in the past but also toppers in the last 14 years at All India Level.

In this test series, a total of 20 tests will be conducted, covering the entire syllabus of class XI & XII. Out of these 20 tests, 4 tests will be on partwise syllabus of class XI followed by 1 complete syllabus test, 4 tests will be on partwise syllabus of class XII followed by 1 complete syllabus test, 4 tests on AIPMT Prelim. pattern, 2 tests on AIPMT Mains Pattern, 1 test on MAHE Manipal pattern, 1 test on AFMC Pattern and 2 tests on AIIMS Pattern as per schedule given in Despatch Schedule. Please note that no study material will be provided in this course.

AIPMT 2012: The All India Aakash Test Series for Medical comprises of 30 tests with an option of online/offline (at the test centre) mode which prepares the students for AIPMT and other Medical Entrance Exams. These tests have been prepared by our expert faculty which has not only produced excellent results in the past but also toppers in the last 14 years at All India Level.

In this test series, a total of 30 tests will be conducted. Out of 30 tests, 10 tests will be conducted in the first year covering entire class XI syllabus and 20 tests will be conducted in the second year covering the entire syllabus of XI & XII. The test series includes partwise and complete syllabus tests on the pattern of AIPMT Prelims., AIPMT Mains, MAHE-Manipal, AIIMS and AFMC-Pune as per schedule given in Despatch Schedule. Please note that no study material will be provided in this course.

Each student shall be given an Username & Password to see/download the answers & solutions of each test which shall be available on our website at www.aakashinstitute.com on the consecutive day of each test. These answers & solutions shall be available on our website only for 5 days.

Test Mode

The test series is available in two modes Online as well as Offline. In case the student opts for Online Tests:

- (a) The student shall be sent a unique username & password via SMS on their mobile to appear in the Online Test. Therefore it is mandatory for each student to provide their mobile no.

Once a choice about Offline or Online is made by the student, it will not be changed during the course of the year. However, in exceptional circumstances if a student wishes to change the mode of tests, then he/she will have to pay Rs. 500/- towards the change.


Result

- ❖ The centrewise result of the tests will be given at the test centre as per schedule given in the brochure.
- ❖ The students can also see their All India Ranking on our website www.aakashinstitute.com one day prior to the date of result mentioned in the schedule.
- ❖ The result of each test shall be available on our website & each student shall be given an Username and Password so that he/she can see their result and ranking as per the scheduled date.

Instructions for candidates

1. The duly filled Admission Form should be sent to the Registered Office only in a self-addressed envelope (enclosed with the form).
2. Centre Name & Test Mode must be mentioned on the admission form.
3. Entry in the examination hall at every centre is strictly with the Exam. Hall Ticket only.
4. All students must bring Ball Point Pen with them. They shall not be allowed to borrow pen during examination.
5. It is mandatory to use blue/black Ball Point Pen to darken the appropriate circle in the answer sheet.
6. Rough work must not be done on the Answer sheet.
7. Do not use white-fluid or any other rubbing material on answer sheet. No change in the answer once marked is allowed.
8. Student cannot use log tables and calculators or any other material in the examination hall.
9. Before attempting the question paper, student should ensure that the test paper contains all pages and no page is missing.
10. In each test, every correct answer carries 4 marks. One mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer from the total score of the candidate. However, in AIIMS test, negative marking will be 1/3.
11. Before handing over the answer sheet to the invigilator, candidate should check that Roll No. and Centre Code have been filled and marked correctly.

Note: Students are requested to send at least five photocopies of admit cards of their Roll No's of various Medical Entrance Exams to the Registered Office latest by 1st March, 2011 (for Medical-2011) & 1st March, 2012 (for Medical 2012). As soon as we receive the photocopies of your admit cards, we will despatch two Rehearsal test papers; one on the pattern of BHU Prelim. Exam. and another one on the pattern of AIIMS Exam.
