FEE STRUCTURE FOR BCA:

The comprehensive fees for the academic year are listed below. Please keep in mind that if your home institution pays **BCA** directly, the program fees do not apply, and you will simply follow your school's tuition and fee policies.

***note in above total all living Expenses are added and the detail of living expense is as follows:**

Living Expenses:

An average international student in Australia can expect to pay approximately about a week on:

- Accommodation
- Homestay with meals: \$110—270/week
- Hostels and guest houses:\$80—135/week
- Shared accommodation:\$70—250/week
- Rental accommodation:\$100—400/week
- Campus accommodation:\$80—250/week

- Food: \$75/week including Groceries and occasional eating out.
- Clothing: \$10/week many students bring most clothes from home and purchase only a few things.
- Entertainment: \$70/week; includes a film a dinner or night out etc.
- Transport: \$15/week most students buy a weekly transport pass.
- Telephone: \$20/week will vary greatly depending on each students' use of mobile phones, international calls etc.
- Gas/Electricity: \$10/week; the cost for utilities will decrease per person on shared accommodation.
- Books: \$50 -\$100 per book; will depend on the type of course.

You could spend more or less depending on where you live, your lifestyle and your course.

FEES FOR MCA:

For MCA you have to pay almost \$9,000 to 16,000 depending upon different college standard...

Other costs if you are doing BCA/MCA from abroad for which you should budget include:

Domestic and international airfare to the program - approximately *\$1,600* from the East Coast

Visa - approximately *\$500*

U.S. Passport - *\$110*

Textbooks/Printing - *\$300*

Additional lab and course fees not included in Macquarie tuition Personal/entertainment expenses - *\$500* per month
