Eligibility Criteria for Occupational Therapy Courses offered in India

The aspirant who wants to pursue bachelor degree in Occupational Therapy must be a national of India with at least 17 years of age. They must have passed XII intermediate examination. This intermediate study must include subjects of physics, chemistry and biology. Those who want to do a master's degree in the related field must possess a graduate degree in Occupational Therapy. After successful completion of master's degree there is chance to undergo scientific research in the related field. The course duration of the bachelor degree in Occupational Therapy is 4 years. The license for practice after this course will be got, only if it is pursued from any recognized University. Besides this, the aspirant has to pass national certification exam. Aspirants can also find jobs as Occupational therapy assistant in this field. The qualification required to acquire such a job is an Associate Degree or Certificate program in Occupational Therapy.
