Read the following passage and answer the questions given bell Managing, like all other practices—whether medicine, music composition, engineering, accountancy, or even baseball is an art. It is know-how. It is doing things in the light of the realities of a situation. Yet managers can work letter by using the organized knowledge about management. It is this knowledge that constitutes a science. Thus, managing as practice is an art; the organized knowledge underlying the practice may be referred to as a science. In this context science and art arcmot mutually exclusive; they are complementary.

As science improves, so should art, as it has sarpened in the physical and biological sciences. To be sure, the science under on a nanaging is fairly crude and inexact. This is true because the many variables with which managers deal are extremely complex. Nevertheless, such management knowledge can certainly improve manegerial practice. Physicians without the advantage of science would be little more than witch doctors. Executives who attempt to manage without management science must trust to luck, intuition or what they did in the past.

In managing, as in any other field, unless practitioners are to learn by trial and error and it has been said that managers' errors are their subordinates' trials. There is no place they can turn or meaningful guidance other than the accumulated knowledge underlying their practic
