- (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education, 2010 (Appendix-B).

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS & ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

- 1. The university reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post at any time without assigning any reason. The right is also reserved with the university either to fill or not to fill any or all the posts and its decision in this regard shall be final.
- 2. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for interview.
- 3. The university reserves its right to place reasonable limit on the total number of candidates to be called for interview.
- 4. Stringent criteria may be applied for short-listing the candidates to be called for interview.
- 5. Minimum requirements of qualifications and/or experience can be relaxed in respect of exceptionally qualified candidates by the screening/selection committee with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.
- 6. Higher initial pay may be given to exceptionally qualified and deserving candidates.
- 7. Applicants not found suitable for higher positions may be considered for lower position in the same area of specialization.
- 8. Minimum qualifications will be as per UGC Regulations, 2010.
- 9. Relaxation of 5% marks will be provided at the Master's level in the case of SC/ST/Physically Handicapped candidates and to those Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 10. Reservation Policy will be followed as per Govt. of India Rules, wherever applicable. The SC/ST/OBC /PH candidates are required to attach necessary certificate(s) on prescribed format.
- 11. The process of selection may be by a written test/ presentation/ interview or a combination thereof.
- 12. Application should be accompanied with a non-refundable demand draft of Rs. 500 / for general category and Rs. 125 for SC/ST and handicapped candidates drawn in favour of the Central University of Himachal Pradesh payable at Dharamshala.
- 13. The application duly filled in the prescribed form must reach in the office of the **Registrar**, **Central University of Himachal Pradesh**, **Post Box No.21**, **Dharamshala**, **District Kangra 176215**, **Himachal Pradesh** on or before 6th **July**, **2011**. Applications received after this date shall not be considered. University will not be responsible for any postal delay.

- 14. The service conditions including pay band and age of superannuation shall be as per UGC rules/norms.
- 15. The applicants serving in Government/Semi-Government organization/Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Organizations must send their applications "Through Proper Channel." The applications received without the recommendations of the employers will not be considered. However, an advance copy of application may be sent followed by the original application through proper channel.
- 16. Candidates shall have to produce original documents at the time of Test/Interview.
