## COMBINED EXAMINATION FOR THE POSTS OF DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE AND FOR THE POSTS OF UNDER SECRETARY & EQUIVALENT

In continuation to the above Advertisement inviting applications for filling up of 25 (twenty five) posts of Jr. Grade of State Civil Service as Under Secretary and equivalent, this is to inform all applicants that **O2 (two) posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police under Police Department have been included** for combined examination as per the following Roster Points.

The post of **Deputy Superintendent of Police** carries the pay scale in the Pay Band- $2\sim9300-34800$  and **Grade Pay of Rs.**  $5400/\sim$  and the post of **Under Secretary & equivalent** carries the pay scale in the Pay Band-2-9300-34800 and **Grade Pay of Rs.**  $5000/\sim$ .

The pattern of Examination and the syllabus for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police will be the same as notified earlier for the post of Under Secretary and equivalent.

There will be combined examination for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police and Under Secretary and equivalent.

The Candidates willing to opt for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police are also required to undergo Physical Endurance Test as specified below. The candidates are required to qualify in all the events of the Physical Qualification Test. If they fail in any one of the events they will be treated disqualified for Deputy Superintendent of Police post.

The Physical Standard in terms of Height and Weight are as under: ~

## MINIMUM PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS

Height ~ 5'3" for male candidates (five feet three inches)

Chest - 32 inches with minimum expansion of 2 inches

for male candidates only.

Weight - 50 kg. Minimum for male (fifty Kilogram),

45 kg. Minimum for female (forty five kilogram)

The candidates who have already applied for the post of Under Secretary and equivalent need not apply again for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police as it is a combined examination with a common application form. However, the candidates are required to give their preferences for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police/Under Secretary & equivalent on their qualifying the preliminary examination. A preference form shall be provided by the Commission to the candidates who qualify in the preliminary examination for exercising their options.

There is no separate Application Form for Under Secretary and Deputy Superintendent of Police.

Those candidates, who have not submitted application so far, can submit their application before 4<sup>th</sup> of January, 2013 (Friday) till 03:00 p.m. Application form can be downloaded from <a href="https://www.spscskm.gov.in">www.spscskm.gov.in</a> The form should be filled up by the candidate himself/herself and submitted in the office of the Secretary, Sikkim Public Service Commission, Old West Point School Complex, Below Police Headquarter, Gangtok on any working day between 11:00 a.m. to 03:00 p.m. on production of original Bank Receipt of State Bank of Sikkim, for Rs. 150/~ credited to '0051-SPSC'. The amount so deposited shall not be refunded or adjusted against any other purpose.

Further, in view of the decision of the State Government the following subjects have been added in the list of Optional Subjects prescribed for the post of Under Secretary and equivalent under Section 3 Part B & Part C of the earlier advertisement.

- 1. Electronics and Communication
- 2. Computer Science & Engineering
- 3. Mass Communication & Journalism, and
- 4. Tourism Management.

However, notwithstanding the addition of above mentioned subjects, the candidates will not be allowed to offer the following combinations:-

- 1. Computer Science & Engineering with Electronics and Communication and any other Engineering subjects.
- 2. Tourism Management with Management subject and Public Administration and Geography.

Accordingly, the last date of submission of filled in application forms have been extended upto 4<sup>th</sup> of January, 2013 (Friday) till 03:00 p.m..

Further, the candidates willing to opt any one of the above mentioned subjects as optional subjects for the main examination are also advised to visit the office of the Commission latest by 4<sup>th</sup> of January, 2013 (Friday) till 03:00 p.m. for corrections of their subjects in their application forms already submitted.
