- 1 Only **original fee receipts** must be submitted with the form. A breakup of the fees from the colleges must be submitted by all students, if the same is not available in the fee receipt. (eg. Tuition fees, term fees, gymkhana fees, miscellaneous fees and so on)
- 2 Students receiving their results in the GPA grading system will have to work out their grades in the % format and attach the working along with the form. (working to be done by the college)
- 3 A copy of the MH-CET results must be attached by all students. MBBS students to attach no dues certificate.
- 4 All marksheets should be duly attested.
- 5 Original letter from the Principal / Dean of the respective college in the format as attached must be **submitted along with the form by all students.**
- 6 Forms to be verified and forwarded by the Principal / Dean of the college
- 7 INCOME
Salaried persons :
Annual IT returns and Form no.16 for the year ended March 2009. Duly attested xerox copies of the IT returns have to be submitted. These copies are to be attested either by the Chartered Accountant or by the office of the parent.
- 8 For farmers and persons who work in the rural areas:
Latest original tahsildar's certificate / gram panchayat certificate / affidavit as income proofs for the current year i.e. 2009 – in original
- 9 For retired persons:
IT returns for the year ended March 2009 along with supporting proofs – duly attested. A summary statement of the income from April 2009 to date from all sources (with proofs), copy of the bank passbook. (documents to be attested by the bank)
- 10 For businessman:
IT returns - company and personal – for the year ended March 2009 – duly attested. If the returns are not being filed then an official letter from the CA to that effect and to mention the yearly income along with a statement of income for the same.
