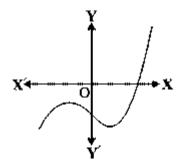

- 6. Find the zeroes of the polynomial  $x^2 3$  and verify the relationship between the zeroes and the coefficients. (3 marks)
- 7. Find the zeroes of the quadratic polynomial  $x^2 2x 8$  and verify the relationship between the zeroes and the coefficients. (3 marks)
- 8. Find the zeroes of the quadratic polynomial  $4s^2 4s + 1$  and verify the relationship between the zeroes and the coefficients. (3 marks)
