1. DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED

- a). DD towards Registration fee and other charges.
- b). Proof of Date of Birth: Class 10th admit card and/or 10th pass marks sheet/ 10th pass certificate indicating Date of Birth, duly attested by a Chartered Accountant/ Gazetted Officer/ Head of the Institution.
- c) 12th pass marks statement if already passed (duly attested by a Chartered Accountant/ Gazetted Officer/ Head of the Institution.)
- d) If student is foreigner, enclose proof of attested copy of nationality.
- e) Attested copy of proof of special category

2. Amount payable :

- a) In respect of fresh candidate (including erstwhile Foundation/PE-I students) registering CPT course after passing 10th Standard – Rs.6000/- course fee + Rs. 200/- CA Students' Journal Subscription (optional but strongly recommended) + Rs. 400/- CA Members' Journal subscription (optional)
- b) Rs. 100/- for Prospectus including application form.

3. Demand Draft / Pay Order of requisite amount to be drawn in favour of "The Secretary, The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India" payable at New Delhi / Kanpur / Mumbai / Chennai / Kolkata in accordance with the postal address given in Column 5 (a) of the application and appropriate office of the Institute mentioned in the Point 7 below.

4. In case a student applies online, he/she should take a print out of the application, affix a photograph, sign the application and dispatch to the appropriate office of the Institute within 7 days from the date of online registration by speed or registered post.

5. Eligibility requirement for appearing in CPT Examination:

CPT registered student entitled to appear in Common Proficiency Test after he appeared in the Senior Secondary Examination(10+2 examination) conducted by an examining body constituted by law in India or an examination recognised by Central Government as equivalent thereto. * Please refer Para 6 below.

Students have to complete 60 days from the date of registration and upto the first day of the month in which an examination takes place.

Students intending to appear in CPT examinations to be held in June and December must get themselves registered on or before 1st April and 1st October respectively.

A separate examination form has to be filled in.

A student has to follow the examination notification to be issued by the Examination Department of the ICAI on our website www.icaai.org and apply in the prescribed form and adhere to other terms and conditions.
