3. Estimate the contribution of Ācariya Dhammapāla to Pāli literature. 60

- (c) Therīgāthā
- (d) Dīpavaṃsa

following Pāli prosodies : 10×3=30

Indavajirā ; Vaṃsatilakā ; Mālinī ;  
Sikhiriṇī.

8. Translate the following passages with annotation  
on the words underlined : 30×2=60

(a) Rājā āha : Bhante Nāgasena, kiṃlakkhaṇā  
saddhā ti.—Sampasādanalakkhaṇā ca  
mahārāja saddhā sampakkhandanalakkhaṇā  
cāti.—Kathambhante sampasādanalakkhaṇā

saddhā ti.—Saddhā kho mahārāja  
uppajjamānā nīvaraṇe vikkhambheti,  
 vinīvaraṇaṃ cittaṃ hoti acchaṃ  
 vippasannaṃ anāvilam, evaṃ kho mahārāja  
 sampasādanalakkhaṇā saddhā ti.—  
 Opammaṃ karohīti.—Yathā mahārāja rājā  
 cakkavattī caturaṅginiyā senāya saddhiṃ  
 addhānamaggapaṭipanno parittaṃ udakaṃ  
tareyya, taṃ udakaṃ hatthīhi ca assehi ca  
 rathehi ca pattīhi ca khubhitam bhavye  
 āvilam lulitam kalalībhūtam, uttiṇṇo ca rājā  
 cakkavattī manusse āṇapeyya : pāṇīyaṃ  
 bhane āharatha, pivissāmīti, raṇṇo  
 udakappasādako maṇi bhavye, evaṃ  
 devāti kho te manussā raṇṇo cakkavattissa  
 paṭissutvā taṃ udakappasādakaṃ maṇiṃ  
 udake pakkhipeyyuṃ, tasmim udake  
 pakkhittamate saṅkha-sevālapanaṃ  
 vigaccheyya kaddamo ca sannisīdeyya,  
 acchambhavye udakaṃ vippasannaṃ  
 anāvilam, tato raṇṇo cakkavattissa pāṇīyaṃ  
 upanāmeyyuṃ : pivatu devo pāṇīyan-ti.

- (b) So evaṃ samāhite citte parisuddhe  
 pariyodāte anaṅgaṇe vigatupakkilesu  
 mūdū-bhūte kammaniye ṭhite ānejjappatte  
 āsavānaṃ khaya-ñāṇāya cittaṃ abhiniharati  
 abhininnāmeti. So 'idaṃ dukkhan' ti  
 yathā-bhūtam pajānāti, 'ayaṃ dukkha-  
 samudayo' ti yathā-bhūtam pajānāti,

‘ayaṃ dukkhanirodha’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ  
 pajānāti, ‘ayaṃ dukkha-nirodha-gāminī  
 paṭipadā’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ pajānāti, ‘ime  
 āsavā’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ pajānāti, ‘ayaṃ  
 āsavasamudayo’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ pajānāti,  
 ‘ayaṃ āsava-nirodho’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ  
 pajānāti, ‘ayaṃ āsava-nirodha-gāminī  
 paṭipadā’ ti yathā-bhūtaṃ pajānāti. “Tassa  
 evaṃ jānato evaṃ passato kāmāsavā pi  
 cittaṃ vimuccati bhavāsavā pi cittaṃ  
 vimuccati avijjāsavā pi cittaṃ vimuccati,  
 vimuttasmiṃ vimuttaṃ” iti nāṇaṃ hoti,  
 “khīṇā jāti vusitaṃ brahmacariyaṃ kataṃ  
 karaṇīyaṃ nāparaṃ itthattāyāti” pajānāti.
