2. "Ngugi's A Grain of Wheat is a fictional portrayal of Kenyan history." Discuss.

Discuss the relevance of the Court of Mata Kharibu or the play within a play in Soyinka's A Dance of the Forests.

3. "Naipaul's *A House for Mr. Biswas* brings forth the crisis of identity formation." Do you agree? Give a reasoned answer.

4. Explain Walcott's concern with language and history taking examples from any two poems in your course. 20

How does the Mandala motif work at the level of theme and structure in White's *The Solid Mandala*?
