New rate of scholarship applicable w.e.f. Madhyamik Pariksha(SE) 2004 onwards as follows:-

1. 11 & 12th classes of 10+2 pattern / Intermediate Rs. 300/- per month

2. Diploma in Professional and Engineering Studies Rs. 750/- per month

Eligibility

- A student shall not receive any other Scholarship/Stipend for a course of study for which he is in receipt of National Merit Scholarship Scheme.
- 2. A student in full time employment will not be eligible for award of a Scholarship.
- A Scholar under this scheme while availing Scholarship can enjoy fee concession given by the institution in which he/she is studying.

Parental Income Celling

Scholarship will be paid only to those students whose parent's / guardian's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum for all categories under the scheme.

- The income of father, mother, guardian and husband in case of married girl students will be taken as income.
- ii) In the case of parent / guardian drawing salary, the Dearness Allowance, City Compensatory Allowance, House Rent Allowance, Conveyance Allowance, Interim Relief and Overtime Allowance etc. shall not be included in determining the income. Deputation: Allowance, Honorarium, Special Pay and Bonus etc. shall however be treated as income.

Payment of Scholarship

- i) The Scholarship will be paid for a period of 10 (ten) months in an academic year.
- ii) Payment of Scholarship to the eligible students will be in favour of Head of the Institution concerned where he/she is studying H.S. or Diploma Course.

Duration

Scholarship is renewable from year to year within the same stage of education. For example Scholarship awarded to a student in 11th class can be renewed for 12th class only.

Miscellaneous

The practice of awarding the certificate of merit and one time Rs. 100/- to meritorious students who become ineligible due to income of parents of exceeding Rs. 1.00 lakh has been discontinued.
