- b) Qualified in an entrance examination to be conducted by the University at the national level on the pattern of UGC/CSIR.

However, candidates holding an M-Phil. Degree or having at 5 (five) or more years of teaching/practical/industry/professional experience (Category 'A') or who have already cleared JEST of DAE or UGC-NET or GATE of IIT will be exempted from appearing in the Entrance Examination. Candidates under 'Category A' above shall make a presentation of their research proposal before the Doctoral Committee. The candidates under the category 'B' above will undergo the Course Work before/alongside undertaking dissertation work. The Doctoral Committee may also prescribe the course work partly or fully to the candidates under the Category 'A' based on the discipline he/she studied. The Economics faculty with the help of Doctoral Committee shall decide the course work to be assigned to students.

- a) Through an entrance test followed by an interview to be conducted by the University at the National Level. However, the candidates who have already cleared JEST of DAE or UGC-NET or GATE of IIT will be exempted from appearing in the entrance test.
