**PROSPECTUS**

**1. ELIGIBILITY:-**

Candidate should be a citizen of India.

**2. NATIVITY:-**

Candidate should be a Native of Tamil Nadu. Except the candidates who have studied in the schools in State of Tamil Nadu from 8th Standard to Plus Two, others should produce the **Nativity Certificate in the format prescribed in Annexure I** from the competent authority. The candidates who are the children of parents of Tamil Nadu origin, but living in other states should also produce the Nativity certificate as mentioned above. Permanent Residence Certificate will not be accepted.

**Note:-** Producing false nativity certificate if detected at any time later during the course of study will result in expulsion of the candidate and also initiation of criminal proceedings against the candidate as well as the parents as per law.

**3. AGE LIMIT : -**

**FOR B.Sc., (NURSING) COURSE:-**

Candidates should have completed 17 years of age and maximum age is 30 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2010. For SC / SCA / ST candidates maximum age raised to 35 years. Evidence should be produced.

**FOR B.PHARM., BPT, B.O.T COURSE:-**

Should have completed the age of Seventeen years on or before 31st December 2010. Evidence should be produced.

**4. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS: -**

Candidates should have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying Examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board or any other equivalent examination in one and the same attempt in the following group of subject with minimum eligible marks.

**5. MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY MARKS: -**

(a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.

(or)

(b) ) Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Maths with any other subjects

**(a) B.PHARM.,**

**All Categories other than SC / SCA / ST: -**

Individual pass in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Botany and Zoology or Mathematics both in Theory and Practical with a minimum of 35% of marks and with not less than 50% aggregate marks in the above subjects.

**For SC / SCA / ST Candidates: -**

Individual pass in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Botany and Zoology (or) Mathematics both in Theory and Practical with a minimum of 35% of marks and with not less than 40% aggregate marks in the above subjects.

**English:- A Pass in English with a minimum of 35% marks is mandatory for all categories.**

**(b) B.Sc., (Nursing)**

**All Categories other than SC / SCA / ST: -**

Individual pass in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Botany and Zoology (both Theory and Practical) and English with a minimum of 35% marks in each of above subjects and with a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

**For SC / SCA / ST candidates: -**

5% relaxation for aggregate marks.

**(c) B.P.T.,**

**All Categories:**

Individual pass in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Botany and Zoology (both Theory and Practical) with a minimum of 35% of marks in each of the above subjects is mandatory.

**English:** A Pass in English with a minimum of 35% marks is mandatory.

**(d) B.O.T Course for all categories:**

Individual pass in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology with a minimum of 35% in English, & Separate minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology.

**NOTE: -**

- (i) The marks obtained in the qualifying examinations in the relevant science subjects in first appearance only will be taken into consideration for the allotment of seats to the candidates and the improvement marks in +2 examination of any year will not be considered.
- (ii) Candidates who have passed any other equivalent examinations with same group of subjects mentioned above should produce the eligibility certificate from Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University before admission to the course.

- (iii) In the case of candidates who have furnished the mark- sheets of the qualifying examination, only in GRADES, the minimum marks of the grades alone will be taken into consideration while determining the marks in the Science subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology.
- (iv) Candidates who have submitted mark sheets with GRADES should obtain the mark equivalent certificates from the examination authority and attach a certified copy along with their mark sheet as an enclosure with the application
- (v) Normalization method will be adopted for calculating the minimum eligibility mark for the candidates who have passed any other equivalent examination.

**6) Normalization of Marks:-**

- (i) The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority will be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board (Government of Tamil Nadu) by adopting the method of normalization.

**Explanation:-**

Under the method of normalization the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.

**Illustration:-**

If the highest marks secured by the student of State Board in Physics is 100 and the highest mark secured by a student of any other Board in the same subject is 90, both the highest marks will be considered to be equal to 100. If a student of the other Board secures 60 marks in Physics when the first mark in Physics in the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below:-

$$\frac{100 \times 60}{90} = 66.66\%$$

- (ii) After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards will be merged into a common merit list.

7. (i) Candidates who have passed H.Sc., in vocational stream are not eligible to apply to Para Medical Courses.

- (ii) Candidates both Male and Female seeking admission to **B.Sc., (Nursing)** course should be **unmarried**. If the candidate gets married after admission while undergoing the course he / she shall NOT be permitted to continue the course of study and shall be **expelled** from the institution. The ratio between men and women shall be **1 : 9** respectively in the selection of candidates.

#### **8. METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:-**

- (i) Ranking will be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates in the prescribed science subjects in the qualifying examinations reduced to the base of 200 marks. The marks obtained through different boards will be taken into account after normalization.

#### **CALCULATION**

Weighted total marks for a maximum of 200 Either (X+Y) OR (Z+Y) OR (W+Y)  
The percentage and the weighted total should be accurate to two decimals.

- ii) Ranking of the candidates will be done based on the total marks obtained in the relevant science subjects after normalization of marks computed to a maximum of 200.
- iii) a) The improvement marks of any year in +2 examination are not valid and only the marks obtained in the first appearance in the qualifying examination will be taken into consideration for the selection and allotment of candidates to Para Medical Courses.  
b) Any application submitted without the recently attested Xerox copy of the first appearance mark sheet of the qualifying examination will summarily be rejected.

#### **Note:-**

In respect of the candidates who have taken the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology will be taken into account for arriving the General merit list and for those candidates who have taken Physics, Chemistry, Maths along with other subjects (other than Biology, Botany and Zoology) the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Maths will be taken into account for arriving the merit list for B. Pharmacy course alone.

#### **(iv) DETERMINATION OF RANK OF CANDIDATES OBTAINING EQUAL MARKS:**

In cases where two or more candidates obtain equal aggregate for 200, the rank of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order

- (a) Percentage in Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together in +2 Examination.
  - (b) Percentage in Chemistry in +2 examination.
  - (c) Percentage in Fourth Optional subject in +2 Examination.
  - (d) Date of Birth – Weightage given to seniority in age.
  - (e) Computerised Random number assigned. Higher value of random number will be taken into consideration.
- (v) The Merit List will be published in the **Notice Board** at the office of the Selection Committee and will be available on the website: <http://www.tnhealth.org/> / [www.tn.gov.in](http://www.tn.gov.in)
- (vi) The selection will be made on merit basis and by counselling applying the rule of reservation / Roster method followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu whichever is applicable.

The rule of reservation shall be as follows:-

Open Competition	-	31%
Backward Class	-	26.5%
Backward Class Muslim	-	3.5%
Most Backward /Denotified	-	20%
Scheduled Caste	-	15%
Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyars	-	3%
Scheduled Tribe	-	1%

BC, BCM, MBC, SC, SCA & ST are eligible for selection under open competition as per merit in addition to the reservation made for them.

- (vii) Counselling Schedule for admission will also be available on the websites: - [www.tnhealth.org/](http://www.tnhealth.org/) / [www.tn.gov.in](http://www.tn.gov.in) for all candidates. Candidate who does not get the call letter can also attend the counselling session during his/her turn.

## 9. COUNSELLING (Single Window System):

- (i) Option once exercised during counselling will be Final. At the time of counselling, candidates can choose the training centres of their choices on merit basis and the same will be allotted as per the availability of seats and **no change of centre will be entertained after allotment.**
- (ii) a) Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their name will not be considered later.
- b) The Selection Committee reserves the right to permit the candidate who absented himself for previous counselling with valid reason for his absence, to attend the subsequent counselling and he / she will be allowed to take the course and college available at the time of counselling when he / she actually attends and this is restricted to only once.

- (iii) One of the Parents will be allowed to attend the counselling. They should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session. Individual intimation will be sent for regular counselling through call letter.
- (iv) All Communications will be sent only to the mailing address given in the application form. Candidates are requested to intimate to the Selection Committee any change of address immediately. The Intimation/Call letters will be sent either by Certificate of Posting, Registered Post, Speed Post, Courier Service or by Telegram whichever is feasible. Selection Committee is not responsible for any postal delay or non receipt of call letters.
- (v) Candidates can exercise their option for the course and the college of their own choice at the time of counselling, and allotment will be subjected to availability of seats. **Individual request for transfer of college or change of course will not be entertained after counselling is over.**
- (vi) Those who get Retotalled / Revalued marks can also attend the counselling on the day and session according to their new marks. If the candidate produces the Retotalled / Revaluation marks after the counselling is over and within the cut off date then his/her name, will be considered in the existing vacancies available and he / she can not claim any preferential rights for allotment according to merit under Retotalling /Revalued marks. Candidates who submit the Revaluation / Retotalling marks after the administrative cut-off dates fixed by Government will not be considered for selection.
- (vii) The vacancies arising after the first phase of counselling will be filled up from the waiting list through counselling, if necessary, and also to the new colleges, if any added.
- (viii) The movement of candidate from one category to another category and from one college to another college will be based on the merit following the rule of reservation.
- (ix) If a candidate chooses a seat in Self-Financing College category when seats are available in Government college he/she has to give a declaration to that effect.
- (x) Candidate getting allotment for any reason at a later date after the Counselling was over, will be given a seat in the existing vacancies available in any one of the Colleges.
- (xi) **Mutual transfer will not be permitted.**

#### **10. Choice of Candidates: -**

Candidates can choose course/college as per availability at the time of Counselling. If the course of his/her choice is not available, he/she can give option to the **Waiting List** for one course only. Candidates cannot be waitlisted for Colleges.

## 12. CATEGORIES OF SEATS :-

### (i) CATEGORY 1-GOVERNMENT COLLEGES:

#### i) (a) **B.Sc.,(NURSING) :-**

Seats available in College of Nursing at Madras Medical College, Chennai and Madurai Medical College, Madurai and Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu.

#### (b) **B.PHARM.,:-**

Seats available in College of Pharmacy at Madras Medical College, Chennai and Madurai Medical College, Madurai.

#### (c) **BPT.,:-**

Seats available in College of Physiotherapy, Government Institute of Rehabilitation Medicine, K.K.Nagar, Chennai-83 and Government College of Physiotherapy, Periyamelaguparai, Trichy.

### (ii) CATEGORY II – GOVT. QUOTA IN SELF FINANCING PARAMEDICAL INSTITUTIONS :-

**a)** 65% of total seats in each Para Medical Course in Self- Financing Non-Minority Institution.

**b)** 50% of total seats in each Para Medical Course in Self-Financing Minority Institution surrendered to Government Quota will be filled as per merit following rule of reservation in force.

**c)** However, if the Self-Financing Institutions express their willingness to offer seats voluntarily in addition to the seats clause 12(ii)(a) or (b) for allotment of candidates through Single Window System those seats will be filled up on merit basis from the merit list published by the Selection Committee for 2010 – 2011 session following the rule of reservation.

d) The actual number of seats offered by the Self Financing Institutions will be displayed at the time of Counselling.

**13. DURATION OF THE COURSES: -**

- i. **B.PHARM.,** : 4 years
- ii. **B.Sc., (Nursing)** : 4 Academic years of 8 Semesters
- iii. **B.P.T.,  
(Physiotherapy)** : 4 Academic Years of 8 Semesters and six months compulsory Resident Internship
- iv. **B.O.T.,  
(Occupational  
Therapy)** : 4 Academic years of 8 semesters and six months compulsory Resident Internship

**14. SEATS RESERVED FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES IN GOVERNMENT / SELF FINANCING INSTITUTIONS.**

Seats earmarked for the Special Categories will be allotted following the Horizontal Reservation. **The Seats will be allotted as per merit order in the concerned special category and those seats will be deducted in the concerned compartment (OC / BC / BCM / MBC / DC / SC / SCA / ST) and the remaining seats will be allotted to the General Category. If no eligible candidates are available for the seats earmarked under special category, those seats will be added to general pool and allotted on merit basis.**

**1. SEATS RESERVED FOR THE CHILDREN OF EX- SERVICEMEN : -**

**One Seat in each course of B.Pharm., B.Sc.,(Nursing), B.P.T., is reserved for the Children of Ex-Servicemen**

The candidate should furnish a certificate as prescribed in the format in the Annexure-II, obtained from the competent authority. The committee from the Defence authorities constituted for this purpose will scrutinize certificates submitted by the candidates. Eligible candidates will be selected on merit basis.

The other eligibility conditions for admission to Para Medical Courses will be applicable as in the case of General Category.

**(2) SEATS RESERVED FOR PHYSICALLY DISABLED : -**

3% of the total number of seats available in Government Colleges are reserved for the Physically Disabled candidates. The reservation of seats will be provided for the candidates in the first instance, with disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% . In case candidates are not available in that category then only candidates with disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% will be considered. Seats will not be reserved for candidates with disabilities in vision or hearing.

The other conditions for admission to Para Medical Courses will be applicable as in the case of General Category. The candidates are required to produce a certificate from the District Medical Board of the area concerned constituted for this purpose assessing the nature and the extent of physical disability in the format prescribed in the Annexure III.

The Medical Certificate issued by the District Medical Board of the area concerned for this purpose is subject to the confirmation of the Expert Committee constituted by the Director of Medical Education at the time of counselling.

**The Candidate seeking admission under this category should produce the full size photograph exhibiting the deformity.**

**Note :** (1) The selected candidates for Para Medical Courses will be required to undergo second Medical Examination by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Director of Medical Education to ascertain and confirm their nature and extent of physical disability.

(2) Candidates with any other disability other than the locomotor disability of the Lower limb will not be considered for admission into Para Medical Courses under the Special Category.

(3) The decision of the Director of Medical Education in this regard will be final.

**15.** Counselling for the Special Category will be done before the General Category.

**16.** Candidates should affix passport size photographs taken within three months prior to submission of application and duly attested by Group A or Group B officer of Government of Tamil Nadu or Central Government or the Head of the Institution last studied in the place provided in the application form.

**17. All the entries in the application form should be written legibly by the candidate in his / her own handwriting.**

The candidate should ensure that all information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him / her in the application and the enclosure are correct. The candidate is informed that if after proper scrutiny of his / her application it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct or any other information is found to be incorrect:-

**a.** he/she will forfeit the admission no matter at what stage of the course he/she will be at that time;

**b.** he/she will be debarred from pursuing any studies for a period of three years;

**c.** legal action will be instituted against the candidates and the parents for furnishing incorrect information;

**d.** criminal action will be instituted against him/her and Parents / Guardian for furnishing false Mark Sheets / False Community Certificate.

18. Document enclosed with the application will not be returned. Candidates are required to **enclose only the attested Xerox copies** of the following certificates along with the application. Attestation should have been made by Group A or Group B Officer of the State Government or Central Government or by Head of the Institution where the candidate studied.
- (a) Mark sheet H.S.C. (Academic) examination (both side of mark sheets should be Xeroxed).
  - (b) Transfer certificate obtained after the completion of H.S.C. , (Academic) or equivalent courses.
  - (c) Nativity certificate (wherever necessary)
  - (d) **Permanent Community certificate Card.**

**Note:**

- (i) The candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe should produce Community Certificate obtained from Revenue Divisional Officer duly attested a Xerox copy or certified copy of the permanent community Card. For communities linked with Districts (See Annexure) the candidates should obtain their Community Certificate in the respective districts
  - (ii) Genuineness of community certificate should be verified before entering second year Para Medical Courses.
  - (iii) Producing a false community, nativity or any other certificates if detected later at any point of time during the course of study will result in expulsion of the candidate and also criminal proceedings will be initiated against the candidate as well as the parents as per law.
19. The selection and admission of candidates of other Universities / Boards will be provisional subject to approval of the qualifying examination by the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any ground, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will be cancelled.

**20. The Selected Candidates should produce all the original documents at the time of admission to the Deans/Principals of respective Colleges concerned. Selection will be cancelled if the candidates do not produce the original documents at the time of admission.**

**21.** The candidates will be required to undergo Medical Examination at the College to which they are allotted before the Medical Board on the date notified by the authorities of the college. Only those candidates found medically fit will be admitted and be permitted to pay the fees.

**22.** Candidates selected for admission and his / her parent / guardian will have to sign discipline declaration form in Annexure - IV, V, VI and VII. Failure to sign the declaration will result in the cancellation of selection.

**23. Hepatitis – B – Vaccination :-**

All candidates selected for admission to first year para medical course should take the Hepatitis – B vaccine before admission and to produce a certificate as in Annexure –X .

**24.** As per Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University regulations, no admission shall be made after 30th September 2010 for the academic year.

**25.** Candidates can type the necessary certificates in the prescribed format separately and they are requested to attach the same along with the application.

**26.** All selections and admission for Para Medical Courses are only provisional. The Selection and admission is liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be defective or incorrect or and there has been any suppression or misrepresentation of facts. The Selection Committee reserves the right of allotment of Para Medical courses and Colleges.

**27.** Candidate selected for admission to Para Medical Courses are not guaranteed any appointment in Government Service.

**28. Ragging :-** The candidates who join Paramedical courses should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging through out their study period. If they are found to have indulged in ragging any time, the candidate will be removed from the roll of the institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against the candidate.

29. Only legitimate enquiry or any correspondence regarding the selection of candidates will be entertained.

**30. ATTENTION TO CANDIDATES : -**

1. Before filling up the application form and OMR sheet, read all the instructions carefully.
2. Use one common application form for B.Pharm, B.Sc (Nursing), BPT, BOT Courses.
3. Fill up the application form and OMR sheet legibly, neatly and correctly. The information will be processed by using computer. Any mistake committed by the candidate will prejudice the selection.
4. Do not fold any of the forms under any circumstances. Making hole, using pin or staple on the OMR sheet should be avoided.
5. Completed application form with all relevant enclosures prescribed may be delivered in person or sent in the cover provided by Registered Post/Courier Service / Speed Post to reach :-

All prescribed enclosures should only be attested Xerox Copies. Original certificates should not be enclosed. Incomplete applications and the applications received after the due date are liable for rejection.

6. The Secretary, Selection Committee, cannot be held responsible for the rejection of application for delayed receipt or loss in transit on any other ground beyond the specified date and time.
7. Request for extension of time for submission of documents called for after the specified date and time will not be entertained.
8. Any supporting documents received after the due date or application without required documents / particulars will not be entertained.

9. Candidates claiming special category (Physically Disabled and children of ex-servicemen) should apply in the prescribed format for general and also to special categories separately and submit both the applications to the Secretary, Selection Committee, Chennai, if not they will not be considered for admission to Para Medical Courses for General and Special Categories.
10. Candidates applying under Special Category should fill up the common application form for General Category and also they should apply in the application form prescribed for Special Category on payment of Rs.100/- in the form of Demand Draft. Without required documents, their claim will not be considered under any circumstances.
11. Candidates selected under General Category will not be allowed to claim the very same status in the Special Category and vice versa.
12. No Mobiles/ Recordable instruments will be allowed in the counselling hall
31. The Government orders issued and to be issued from time to time pertaining to any of the matters contained in the prospectus should be read as part and parcel of this prospectus and such terms and conditions in the Government order are deemed to have been incorporated in the prospectus.
