(Admissions for Acharya Nagarjuna University and Krishna University)

All candidates whose ranks (AURPGCET-2010) are covered in this admission schedule are required to appear for counselling with all the original certificates along with three Xerox copies of all certificates. The time shown is the time of commencement of counselling. Candidate who fail to appear for counselling will forfeit their claim for admission. Mere calling for counselling does not entile the candidate for admission. Hence, the candidates are required to come over to the counselling at their own risk. No claim can be made to the Director if the seats are filled prior to the rank of any candidate. Candidates who turn up late for counselling may be considered for admission for vacancies, if any at the end of that session.

The candidates are required to submit declaration for anti-ragging at time of counselling, duly signed by candidate and parent / guardian.

The candidates are required to PAY FEE IMMEDIATELY after receiving allotment letter, either through demand draft or in the Bank counter arranged in the counselling centre.

### **GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION**: Candidate who secure seat shall pay Rs.50/- for Admission Application.

The candidates are required to follow the following guidelines:-

- a) Candidates have to report the registration desk and sign in the register when their ranks are announced. If they fail to report they loose their preference of seat allotment.
- b) They are required to hand over their rank cards (AURPGCET-2010) at the registration desk.
- c) Candidates are required to submit all their original certificates for verification at the verification desk.
- d) They are required to proceed in the order of their ranks to the counselling desk.
- e) Candidates are required to fill the option at the counselling desk and they can select the seat in a college of their choice.
- f) They will be given allotment letter and are required to pay fee in the Bank counter immediately.
- g) The candidates are required to submit the challan at the final desk where they are given final admission letter to proceed to the college for completion of admission process.
- h) In case of candidates getting admission into the University College, they are required to report to the Head of the concerned department. After getting the signature of the Head, they are required go to principal's office for admission.
- All other candidates who secure admission into PG Centres and affiliated colleges are required to report the college / PG Centre with in four working days from the date of admission.
- j) Candidates who wants to appear for sliding are not required to report the college. They are required to appear for sliding and after wards they are required to report the college, failing which their seat will be cancelled and will be allotted to another candidate in the order of merit.
