

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - FIRST YEAR B.TECH MARINE ENGINEERING

The four year B.Tech Marine Engineering course is a course leading to Class IV Marine Engineer Officer Certificate of Competency, awarded by the Directorate General of Shipping, Government of India, after 6 months of sea service, enabling the cadets to become Marine Engineers on board Merchant ships anywhere in the world.

This course is strictly residential.

Entry Requirements:

Academic Standards:

A pass in 10+ 2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 60% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics group, and at least 50% in English at 10th or 12th standard.

Age:

17 to 25 years

SC/ST: Relaxable as per Government guidelines.

Physical and Medical Standards

Medically fit as per the standards set by merchant shipping Medical Examination Rules, 2000 as amended from time to time.

Eye Sight: Distance vision (unaided) 0.5 (values given in Snellen Decimal Notation) (6/12) in each eye or 0.67 (values given in Snellen Decimal Notation). (6/9) in better eye and 0.33 (Values given in Snellen Decimal Notation) and (6/18) in other eye. Normal colour vision

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - GME

1. Tech (Mechanical Engg / Naval Architecture) Degree from an AICTE approved College.
2. Minimum Marks – 50% Overall.
3. Minimum 50% Marks in English in either 10th or 12th Standard.
4. Age: Below 28 years as on the date of start of Course.
5. Medical fitness: certified by a doctor approved by Director General Shipping.
6. Eye Sight: +/- 2.5, No Colour Blindness.
