Note:

- For all posts and across all categories (i.e. Gen/OBC/SC/ST/PWD) Departmental the minimum % of marks required in the qualifying degree is **60%**.
- Only for the post of **Programming Officer**, the 'B' level diploma as defined by Deptt of Electronics and GOI, a **Pass** in the qualifying degree is the **essential criteria**.
- The courses offered by Institutions/ Universities through the regular mode should be approved/ recognized by the necessary statutory bodies for employment to posts and services under the Central Government like Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/UGC/AICTE etc. Candidates who have obtained their qualification through the distance learning/ part time mode are also eligible to apply provided that their qualification is recognized by the relevant statutory bodies for employment to posts and services of the Central Government.
- Calculation of percentage of marks in the qualifying degree is as per university/ institution rules.
- Whenever CGPA/ DGP/ CPI/ DGRA or letter grade in degree is awarded, equivalent % of marks should be indicated in the online application as per norms adopted by concerned Univ/ Instt. Ex-Servicemen:

In the case of Ex-Servicemen and commissioned officers, including EDOs/SCOs, who have rendered at least 5 years military service and have been released on completion of assignment (including those whose assignment is due to be completed within the next one year from the last date for receipt of application) other than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency or on account of physical disability attributable to military service or on invalidment, a maximum relaxation of 5 years will be given. (Notification: 39016/10/79-Ext(C) dt. 15.12.79, 36834/1/2006-Ext (Res) dt.4.10.2012, O.M. 36034/2/2013-Ext(Res) dt. 8.4.2013)

Departmental candidates:

Departmental candidates are eligible for age relaxation to the extent of their service rendered in ONGC.

Note:

- Candidates seeking relaxation as SC/ST/OBC, will have to submit at the time of interview, caste certificate, ONLY in the prescribed proforma meant for appointment to posts under the Government of India from the designated authority indicating clearly the candidates caste, the Act/Order under which the caste is recognised as SC/ST/OBC and the Village/Town the candidate is ordinarily resident of.
- Prescribed format of the caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC & PWD for employment in government under taking is down-loadable from the online application site.
- OBC candidates must ensure that they possess the latest Non-Creamy layer certificate at the time of interview. They must also ensure that the name of their caste (including its spelling) as indicated in the certificate, should be exactly the same as published in the list, notified by the Central Government from time to time. A certificate containing any variation in the caste name will not be accepted.
- The OBC claim of a candidate will be determined in relation to the State (or part of the State) to which his/her father originally belongs. 3. SELECTION PROCESS:

The selection process will comprise of the following:

- GATE - 2015:** The desirous and eligible candidates having the essential qualification for the advertised posts are required to apply and appear in the **Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) -2015**.
- The candidates possessing the requisite essential qualification for the advertised posts are required to apply and appear in the GATE-2015 subjects strictly as mentioned against each post at **S. NO. 2.1. Essential Qualification & GATE Subject with Code under Eligibility Criteria**.
- GATE Online Application/Processing system website for online registration for GATE-2015 Exam shall remain open from 01.09.2014 to 01.10.2014. The candidates are required to apply online during the period.
- GATE-2015 Exams are scheduled to be held from 31.01.2015 to 14.02.2015 on Saturdays and Sundays for different disciplines. The candidates are required to appear in the exam for their respective subjects on the designated date.
- The **GATE-2015 Scores** in the subject mentioned against the posts of ONGC will be considered by ONGC for shortlisting the candidates for the further selection process of Personal Interview as per the criteria decided by the Management.
- The candidates applying for the post in ONGC should qualify in their respective subjects in GATE-2015. From amongst such candidates, the number of candidates to be called for interview will be in the ratio of 1:5 for each Post, as per merit.
- The final merit list shall be prepared based on the weightages assigned to various parameters as per following:

- In order to be selected, candidates, in addition to fulfilling qualification criteria, are required to qualify in the GATE-2015 and thereafter again in the interview separately.
- Departmental candidates shall be given first consideration in matters of selection, while other things such as qualification, eligibility and selection criteria etc. remain the same.
- Only **GATE-2015 Score** is valid for this recruitment exercise in ONGC under this advertisement. Score from GATE-2014 or from any previous GATE examination is not valid.

4. HOW TO APPLY

- Candidates will have to separately apply online to ONGC for which a Link will be activated on www.ongcindia.com, tentatively after January, 2015.
- In ONGC's on-line application, candidates will have to give their **GATE-2015 Registration Number**.
- ONGC will not be responsible if candidates wrongly fill up GATE-2015 Registration Number in ONGC online application. As such, candidates should take care to correctly fill in the GATE-2015 Registration Number.**
- Candidates can apply for only one post even though they may be eligible for more than one Post.**

- On downloading the **GATE-2015** admit card and receipt of **GATE-2015 Registration number**, the candidates may apply to **ONGC ONLINE**. The relevant link will be made available tentatively after January 2015 on the **ONGC's website www.ongcindia.com**.
- Candidates should click on the **ONLINE** application link, read the instructions carefully and fill in the **ONLINE application form** giving accurate information including the **GATE-2015 Registration Number**.
- Candidates must enter the same name in the **same configuration** as they are entering while applying to GATE-2015. (For example, if the candidate is entering Suresh Kumar Pillai in the ONLINE GATE application, he must enter Suresh Kumar Pillai (exactly same spelling) while applying to ONGC ONLINE. He must not enter S.K.Pillai or Suresh K.Pillai while applying to ONGC). The candidates must fill in the **other information boxes correctly** and tick the **appropriate box, wherever applicable**.
