

### **Admission Guidelines**

- 1. Bundelkhand University is conducting Entrance Test named as "Common Eligibility

  Test for Ph.D." (CET), 2016 for admission to Ph.D Programmes in various subject,
  as specified in Table 01 & Table 03.
- 2. The subject wise number of seats for Ph.D is tentative. Any change in seats shall be displayed on university website.
- 3. The syllabus of the CET shall be the same as prescribed for NET/JRF Examinations conducted by the University Grants Commissions (UGC), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) which may be seen from their website. However, the syllabus of Food Technology and Pharmacy shall be made available on University website www.bujhansi.org (www.bujhansi.ac.in)
- 4. CET shall be conducted in the campus of the University.
- 5. Eligibility A candidate applying for admission to Doctor of Philosophy Degree of the University, must hold a Post – Graduate Degree in concerned/allied subject (See Table 1) with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent Letter Grade/Grade Point under the seven Point Letter Grade scale as laid down by the UGC. A relaxation of 5% in minimum marks shall be given to SC/ST and physically handicapped/disabled candidates.

Candidates appearing for Final Year/Final Semester of their postgraduate degree examination are also eligible to apply – subject to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria in the final result at the time of counseling.

'UGC minimum standards and procedures for award of M.Phil. /Ph.D. degree regulation 2009' read with clarification on Guidelines for admission in Ph.D circulated vide Letter No. F.1-1/2002(PS)/Exempt part file III March 2011 shall be applicable with respect to NET qualified candidates. The above mentioned documents are available on University website and also on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

- 6. Application Form shall be filled online only. To submit application form online, the applicant should visit the University website www.bujhansi.org (www.bujhansi.ac.in) and fill the form carefully.
- 7. Registration fee for Online Application Form shall be submitted online through SBI net banking or through ATM/Debit/Credit Card of any nationalized bank. For online


- fee submission, additional bank charges have to be paid. Applicants are advised to note down the Unique ID, BU Reference No., Bank Reference No./ Transaction ID and Application ID for any future communication with the University. After the fee submission, applicants shall be redirected to the University website where options for printing admission form and fee receipt shall be given. Printout of the pay-in-slip of SBI along with the print out of the application form is to be taken by the applicant.
- 8. After attaching the requisite documents (as specified in Table 02) with printout of online admission form along with fee receipt is to be dispatched by registered post to *The Coordinator, Admission Cell 2016, Room No. 105, Administrative Block, Bundelkhand University, Kanpur Road, Jhansi 284128 (U.P.)*. Forms shall not be accepted by hand.
- 9. University reserves the right not to start Ph.D. programme in any subject, if supervisors are not available. Similarly the seats may also be increased if new supervisors are approved.
- 10. The candidate is solely responsible for all the entries in the Form. If the candidate conceals or misrepresents any fact in the entries on the form, his/ her candidature shall automatically stand cancelled and he/ she shall be liable to be debarred from the present and future admissions in the University.
- 11. Entries made by the candidate in the Form shall be considered final, and no subsequent request for change(s) or modification(s) in the same shall be entertained.

#### Note:

The Candidates are strongly advised to go through this information guidelines carefully before filling up form.

### **Guidelines for Entrance Test**

- The CET for Ph.D programmes for the session 2016-17 as specified in Table 01, will be conducted at Bundelkhand University, Jhansi
- 2. Each candidate is required to fill up the OMR sheet carefully.
- 3. The test shall be based on Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) containing two question papers:
  - <u>First Paper</u>— The Paper will be of 100 marks comprising of 100 questions to assess general awareness, academic aptitute and subject proficiency. The duration of the examination will be two hours.



- 4. There shall be no negative marking.
- 5. There shall be minimum qualifying marks for the test i.e. 50 percent marks on the aggregate but minimum 40 percent marks separately in each paper.
- 6. A relaxation of 5 percent in qualifying marks (on the aggregate and in each paper as well) shall be provided to the candidates belonging to the SC/ST/Differently abled.
- 7. The average percentage of marks shall not be rounded off to the next higher integer.
- 8. Black Ball Point Pen should be used for blackening the circles on the answer sheet.
- 9. Correcting fluid should not be used.
- 10. Candidates are not permitted to carry in the examination Hall/Room paper, mobile phone or any other type of gadget for communication.
- 11. Nothing should be written on the Question Booklet except for the Roll No.
- 12. The candidates should ensure that the answer sheet is not folded or damaged and there are no stray marks on the answer sheet.
- 13. The candidate must bring his/her admit card in order to appear in the Entrance Test. If a candidate fails to bring the admit card he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the Entrance Test.
- 14. The Duration of the Examination will be three hours.

### **Exemptions From The Entrance Test**

The following categories of candidates shall be exempted from the CET for admission to Ph.D. programme (See clause 4.16 of Ph.D. Ordinance Bundelkhand University, Jhansi)

- Regular Teachers of the University, its constituent college or a college affiliated/associated to the University, who have completed their probation period successfully.
- 2. International students (including NRIs)
- Candidates selected by the UGC/CSIR/ICAR or other central regulatory bodies for their fellowship.
- 4. UGC/NET qualified.
- 5. Candidates having GATE Score of not less than 75%.
- 6. Serving commissioned officers of Army, Navy and Air force with not less than 15 years of service applying for Ph.D. in Defense and Strategic Studies/Military Science.
- 7. All the candidates desirous of seeking admission to Ph.D Programme whether exempted or not shall have to apply online for CET.
- 8. The categories of candidate exempted for the Eligibility Test (CET) will be given preference over the candidates qualifying through CET.

- 1. High School Certificate (As age proof)
- 2. High School Marksheet
- 3. Intermediate Marksheet & Certificate
- 4. Under Graduate Marksheet & Degree
- Post Graduate Marksheet & Degree
- 6. Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- 7. UGC NET Certificate (if applicable)
- 8. Fellowship certificate of UGC/CSIR/ICAR or other central regulatory bodies. (if applicable)
- 9. 'No Objection Certificate' from present employer, if employed
- 10. Any other relevant certificate

Applicants submitting online forms must submit the print out of online admission form to the above mentioned address by registered post only, failing which their application shall be cancelled.

Use A4 size envelope for sending print out of Admission form. Applicants are advised to write clearly on the envelope "application for admission to Ph.d. Programme in ...................... (session 2016-17)" Do not fold the form.

The candidate should download their admit card for the Ph.D. Entrance test from the University website i.e. www.bujhansi.org, (www.bujhansi.ac.in).
