The other strand was the "empiricist" British line of Hobbes, Locke and Hume.

The British thinkers believed in starting with observable facts; Descartes believed the human senses – of touch or sight or smell – were unreliable. He trusted only the reasoning capacity of the mind. The second founding father of the French intellectual tradition was Rousseau. His utopian vision directly influenced the French Revolution and later French theorists of both Left and Right. Those political definitions were themselves a typically "binary" French invention. Despite the importance afforded to theoretical constructs, the "basic structure" of the secular French state is inviolable. For that reason, a Muslim girl wearing a headscarf in a state school is a threat to the survival of the Republic.
