**INFORMATION REGARDING CUSTOMS**

1. Indian Customs require you to declare goods in excess of the free allowance, prohibited or restricted goods, commercial goods and arms & explosives at Red Channel counter. Export or import of Narcotic drugs, Wildlife and its products and commercial goods are prohibited / restricted. Attempt to export or import these goods can lead to penal consequences, including arrest.
2. Free allowance for residents and tourists of Indian origin are as follows :

Passenger's Age/Period of stay outside India	More than 3 days	Upto 3 days
12 year and above		
a) Returning from Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar or China	Rs.3000/-	Nil
b) Returning from any other country	Rs.12000/-	Rs.6000/-
For a & b	One litre of whisky, one litre of wine and one carton of cigarettes, to be included in free allowance.	
Below 12 years:		
a) Returning from Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar or China	Rs.750/-	Nil
b) Returning from any other country	Rs.3000/-	Rs.1500/-

3. Passengers should declare foreign currency in the currency declaration form if currency notes, bank notes or TC's are in excess of US\$ 10,000 or equivalent and in case of currency notes only if the same are in excess of US\$ 5,000 or equivalent.
4. In case your baggage is mishandled (lost) on arrival, please ensure that you have obtained the Customs endorsement about the unavailed free allowance. In case of any difficulty or complaint, please contact the Custom Officer on duty at the Baggage Reclaim Area.
