**IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING COUNSELING FOR ADMISSION TO 1ST YEAR
OF DEGREE LEVEL ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY INCLUDING PHARMACY COLLEGES. (In terms
of Govt. Order No. 290/Edn(T)/10M-74/09 dated 08.07.2011).**

1. FROM 11TH JULY, 2011 AT YUVA BHARATI KRIRANGAN (SALT LAKE STADIUM) COUNSELING WILL BE DONE BY CENTRAL SELECTION COMMITTEE UNDER AEGIS OF WEST BENGAL JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION BOARD COVERING SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES OF JEM – 2011 EXAMINATION, AIEEE – 2011 EXAMINATION (UPTO 5,00,000 RANK) AND WILLING JELET – 2011 LISTED CANDIDATES;
2. THE STUDENTS WILLING TO BE COVERED UNDER **TUITION FEE WAIVER (TFW) SCHEME** WILL BE TAKEN UP FIRST FOR COUNSELING;
 - a. ELIGIBILITY:
 - i. STUDENTS DOMICILED IN WEST BENGAL;
 - ii. HAVING ANNUAL FAMILY INCOME OF LESS THAN 2.5 LAKH PER ANNUM (UNDER CERTIFICATION OF BDO & ABOVE IN RURAL AND SIMILAR AUTHORITY IN URBAN REGION);
 - b. ADMITTED TO 5% SUPER-NUMERARY QUOTA IN THE ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES/INSTITUTES OF THE STATE;
 - c. ONLY TUITION FEE FOR THE ENTIRE COURSE WILL BE WAIVED.
3. THEREAFTER, COUNSELING FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED, SCHEDULED TRIBE, SCHEDULED CASTE QUOTAS WILL BE FILLED UP;
4. FOLLOWED UP BY COUNSELING FOR AIEEE – 2011 (UPTO 5,00,000 RANK) LISTED CANDIDATES IN 10% OF THE TOTAL STATE-SEATS;
5. SUBSEQUENTLY COUNSELING FOR REMAINING SEATS WILL BE DONE OUT OF JEM – 2011 LISTED CANDIDATES;
6. LASTLY, LEFT OUT SEATS INCLUDING DROP-OUTS WILL BE FILLED UP THROUGH COUNSELING OF WILLING JELET – 2011 LISTED CANDIDATES.
7. THE SEATS STILL REMAINING VACANT WILL BE FILLED UP BY THE RESPECTIVE COLLEGE/INSTITUTE; THROUGH MONITORED DECENTRALISED COUNSELING.
 - a. THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA WILL BE SAME AS APPLICABLE FOR NORMAL COUNSELING.
 - b. THE RESPECTIVE COLLEGE/INSTITUTE WILL NOTIFY THE NUMBER AND NATURE OF VACANCY SEEKING APPLICATION FROM WILLING STUDENTS HAVING JEM – 2011 RANK AND AIEEE – 2011 RANK (NO UPPER LIMIT) THROUGH ADVERTISEMENT ON THEIR WEBSITES AND OTHERWISE.

- c. THOSE STUDENTS WHO HAVE PASSED 10+2 EXAMINATIONS WITH 45% OR MORE MARKS IN PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY AND MATHEMATICS (OR BIOLOGY, AS THE CASE MAY BE) AND 40% FOR SC, ST CANDIDATES; WILL ALSO BE CONSIDERED FOR SELECTION BY THE COLLEGE/INSTITUTION.
- d. ON DAILY BASIS, THE RESPECTIVE INSTITUTION SHALL PUBLISH THE DETAILS OF THE APPLICATIONS RECEIVED FROM WILLING CANDIDATES ON THEIR WEBSITE WITH INTIMATION TO THE GOVERNMENT IN PRESCRIBED FORMAT.
- e. CANDIDATES BASED ON INTER-SE MERIT WITH PRIORITY IN THE ORDER OF JEM – 2011 RANK, AIEEE – 2011 RANK AND THE STUDENTS PASSING 10+2 EXAMINATION WITH PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, MATHEMATICS (OR BIOLOGY) AND SECURING 45% OR MORE MARKS IN THOSE SUBJECTS TAKEN TOGETHER (40% FOR SC/ST STUDENTS) WILL BE ADMITTED TO THOSE VACANT SEATS AFTER APPROVAL OF THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNMENT.
