* These seats shall be treated as “**Payment Seats**” only (as per approval of Government of Andhra Pradesh) to be filled up based on the EAMCET ranks of the candidates as per the rule of reservation and presidential order but with different fee structure (as indicated in the information brochure).

** The title of this degree course is proposed to be changed as B.Sc. (Agri. Business Management) for the batches admitted from the academic year 2014-15 onwards. These students shall be eligible for admission to M.Sc.(Ag.) degree programmes of ANGRAU in the disciplines of Agril. Economics, Agril. Statistics and Agril. Extension only. Further, 50% of seats in M.B.A (ABM) of ANGRAU shall be reserved for the B.Sc.(CABM) admitted batch of students from 2014-15 onwards.

Eligibility:

- A pass in two year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P. or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:
 - i) Physical Sciences
 - ii) Biological or Natural Sciences
- **A candidate under general category for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course, must have passed in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology and obtained 50% marks in aggregate of these subjects at the qualifying examination. In respect of candidates belonging to the SC/ST marks prescribed shall be 10% less than that prescribed for general category(i.e., 40%)**

Criteria for selection:

- The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the **EAMCET-2014** in their respective local areas from out of the merit lists prepared for this purpose. The candidates will be selected based on merit, presidential order, region and social status.
- In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the EAMCET, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration.

Age:

- The candidates for admission to these courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age on 31st December of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Challenged candidates.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist cum Rural Area (Farmers' Quota) :

- **Forty per cent (40%) of the seats in the ANGRAU & Dr.VSRHU and 25% in SVVU are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists (Farmers) owing not less than 3 acres of land either in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidates and who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas. If the land is owned by grandfather, grandmother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable.**
- **FORM-I:** It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate / parents duly certified by the **Mandal Revenue Officer with his office seal (or)** the candidate has to enclose attested xerox copies of **pattadar pass book** as an evidence of the extent of land.
- **Form-II:** It is a proforma to be certified by the **Head Master** of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**).
- **Form-I and Form-II** need to be filled in with the **signatures of concerned officials viz., Mandal Revenue Officer and concerned Head of Institution, respectively**, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Reservation of Seats :

Backward Classes : 29% of seats are reserved under this category.
(BC-A – 7% ; BC-B – 10% ; BC-C – 1% ; BC-D – 7% ; BC-E – 4%)

Scheduled Caste (SC) : 15%

Scheduled Tribe (ST) : 6%

Reservation of seats for Women: In each course, 33 1/3% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of women candidates from each category. (G.O.Ms. No. 75/Edn., dated 13-3-1996 of Govt. of A.P.)

Allocation of seats in favour of Local candidates in relation to Local area:

- Admission to 85% of the seats after excluding those reserved for the candidates from non-local areas / un-reserved (15%) shall be reserved in favour of and allocated among the candidates in relation to the local area in respect of the Andhra University & Nagarjuna University (AU), Osmania University and the Kakatiya University (OU) and Sri Venkateswara University and Sri Krishna Devarayala University (SVU) in the ratio of 42:36:22 respectively.

Hostel facility:

- **Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation.**

Fee: The particulars of fees in respect of U.G. Programmes of three Universities are given hereunder for ready reference. The candidates who are granted admission shall pay the prescribed fees at the time of joining the college and hostel.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:

- Pass Certificate-cum-Memorandum of Marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination (Intermediate)
- Hall Ticket & Rank Card of EAMCET-2014
- SSC or equivalent examination Certificate
- The Community Certificate in the case of candidates belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, signed by the competent authority
- Bonafide or Study certificates (VI to XII)
- Residence Certificate, if necessary
- Transfer Certificate from the College or School where the candidate last studied

- Candidates called for counselling shall have to attend at their own cost
Only one of the Parents / Guardian of the candidate will be allowed for counselling
- The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the above certificates **in Original** at the time of joining the college
