**Draft of the Prospectus 2010-2011 alongwith the table of distribution of seats (Category Wise).**

**M.F.A in Painting**

**Duration:** 4 Semesters (Spread over two years).

**Eligibility:** A candidate for admission to M.F.A. should have passed B.F.A. Painting (10+2+4) or equivalent from Jamia Millia Islamia with 60% marks or a four of five year B.F.A. course from any University recognized by Jamia Millia Islamia with at least 60% of marks.

**Number of seats – 08**

**Admission Procedure:** Admission to the courses will be made on the basis of the merit determined by aggregate of marks in admission test 85 marks (50 marks practical, 35 marks for theory and interview 15 marks).

**Material required:**

- ✓ Candidates should bring brushes Water colour, Acrylic colour, charcoal, Pencil, colour pencil, poster colour, water proof ink, full size drawing board.
- ✓ Paper will be provided by the Department.

## **B.F.A. in Painting**

**Duration:** 4 years full time.

**Eligibility:** An applicant for this course should have passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination or any other equivalent examination recognized by Jamia Millia Islamia and secured at least 50% marks in aggregate of subjects taken into account for awarding divisions.

**Number of seats** – 20

**Admission Procedure:** Admission to the course will be made on the basis of practical and interview for 100 marks (50 marks for practical, 35 marks for theory and 15 marks for interview).

### **Material Required:**

- ✓ Candidate should bring Water colour, charcoal, water bowl, drawing board, pencil 2B, 3B, 4B & instrument box with set square colour pencil, rubber, Water proof ink black and brushes.
- ✓ Paper will be provided by the Department.

### **General Guidelines for admission to BFA**

All the students appearing for admission in BFA courses should follow the given instructions:

**Admission Procedure:** Admission to the course of all B.F.A. candidates will be made on the basis of merit determined by aggregate of marks in practical test of life Drawing and Composition (50 marks), written test (35 marks) and interview (15 marks). It is

compulsory to the candidate to appear in all the three respective tests and interview with portfolio. If a candidate has missed the first test he/she will not be allowed to sit for the other two.

### **Certificate Course in Painting**

**Duration:** 1 year part time (Evening Self Financing Course after 5:00 pm).

**Eligibility:** Secondary School / Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination with atleast 40% marks in aggregate.

**Number of seats – 20**

**Admission Procedure:** The admission to the course will be made on the basis of practical and interview for 100 marks (85 marks for practical and 15 marks for interview).

#### **Material Required:**

- ✓ Candidate should bring charcoal, Water colour, colour pencil, brushes and pencil.
- ✓ Paper will be provided by the Department.
