

SYLLABUS FOR INSTITUTE OF BANKING PERSONAL SELECTION(IBPS)

The IBPS written exam will be conducted on 18th of September 2011. The syllabus is not surprising as it follows the normal bank exam pattern followed in IBPS also, but for computer knowledge, the marks have risen to 50. As similar to other bank exams, IBPS included quantitative aptitude, general awareness, reasoning and English language. And a descriptive paper (commonly known as essay writing and letter writing) which has a weightage of 25 marks and is also included, in 60 minutes. Other than the descriptive section, all questions are of objective type, for every wrong answer, there will be negative marks of 0.25, so be careful while writing the exam, if you know the answer then only you can attempt that question, otherwise it will be a 50-50 chance, which reduces your final score. The candidates who belong to SC/ST can attend pre-examination training in all major cities. If you don't know the answer for a particular question, better leave it, it helps you save time and maximize your score.

quantitative aptitude(50 questions) : 50marks

reasoning(50 questions) : 50 marks

general awareness(50 questions) : 50 marks

computer knowledge(50 questions) : 50 marks

English language (50 questions) : 25 marks

note: for above 5 sections the time duration will be 150 minutes

descriptive on english(essays,letter writing):25 marks—time:60min(1 hour)

the total time for the ibps exam:210 minutes(3 1/2 hrs)
