COUNSELLING OF JELET - 2010

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Instructions to JELET-2010 merit listed candidates seeking admission to 2nd year (3rd Semester) of Engineering Degree Colleges / Institutions and Universities of West Bengal (through Counselling under LATERAL ENTRY scheme)

- 1. The venue of Counselling of JELET-2010 merit listed candidates is "YUBA BHARATI KRIRANGAN, (Salt Lake Stadium), Salt Lake, Kolkata 700 098."
- Counselling Form [downloadable from website : (a) www.csc-et.in (b) www.banglarmukh.com (c) www.wbjeeb.in from 1st August, 2010 2 p.m.] duly filled in should be brought at the time of counselling.
- 3. Counselling fee of Rs. 500/- only (non-refundable) to be paid in the form of Bank Draft payable at Kolkata to be drawn in favour of "Central Selection Committee (E&T)" (The Bank Draft may be purchased from any Bank). The candidate should bring the said Bank Draft at the time of Counselling writing his name, enrolment no. and rank on the reverse side with a ball point pen.
- 4. Allotment of a seat to a candidate is entirely provisional and is subject to his / her (a) securing overall 60% or more marks considering all semesters / parts in Diploma examination without any back paper or (b) overall 60% or more marks in B.Sc. examination with Mathematics as a subject from UGC recognised University (in case of B.Sc. candidates).
- 5. Reservation of seats for SC / ST is applicable to candidates of West Bengal only. SC / ST candidates of other States cannot avail of this facility.
- For Govt. and Govt. aided Engineering & Technological Colleges the reservation of seats for SC / ST and PC candidates will be as per Govt. rules. For Universities / University Departments reservation rules in case of SC / ST and PC candidates of the concerned University shall be followed.
- 7. A candidate called for counselling must report at the venue of counselling on the date and time as notified by the Central Selection Committee (Engineering & Technology) through websites.
- 8. A candidate must appear in person at the counselling venue for allotment of a seat. However, if any candidate is unable to appear at the counselling in person owing to valid reasons under exceptional circumstances, his / her parents / guardians can also appear on his or her behalf with all original testimonials as specified in SI. No. 12 along with the authorisation letter from the candidate to the effect that he or she would not claim for any other seat than the one allotted to his or her parents / guardian through authorisation.

- 9. A candidate failing to appear before the officials at the allotment counter in order of his / her position in the merit-list due to delay on his / her part may be allowed to present himself / herself before the counselling officers immediately after the formalities as the reception counter are over.
- 10. The claim of such candidate (as specified in SI. No. 9) to exercise option shall be limited to the vacancies prevalent at the instant when his / her turn comes for appearing before the counselling officials.
- 11. A candidate can exercise option only to a single branch he / she is eligible of a particular Institution of his / her choice. The option will have to be exercised in writing with his / her signature at the time of counselling. Once the allotment of a seat is done, no further change of the Institution / branch will be entertained. No refund of money will be allowed under any circumstances.
- 12. At the time of counselling candidates should report with the following documents :
 - (i) Duly filled in counselling form
 - (ii) Print out of the result indicating rank / overall rank from the website: www.wbjeeb.in
 - (iii) Bank Draft of Rs. 500/- (non-refundable)
 - (iv) JELET-2010 Admit Card in original
 - (v) SC/ST certificates in original (for SC/ST candidates of West Bengal only) Issued by the competent authority
 - (vi) PC certificate in original (for PC candidates) issued by the competent Authority

The PC candidates claiming seats under reserved category are required to satisfy the following criteria:

For admission to BE/B Tech courses -

For PC (loco motor disorder, visual impairment, speech and hearing impairment) category candidate a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to BE / B Tech courses without any special concession and exemption. The PC candidates belonging to States other than West Bengal are not entitled for admission to Govt. Engineering Colleges.

- (vii) All testimonials <u>in original</u> for verification of eligibility and other criteria i.e. semester wise / part wise / year wise mark sheets of Diploma in Engg/Tech/Pharmacy or B.Sc examination in original and for B.Sc. candidates also original Admit Card/Certificate of Madhyamik (10th standard) or equivalent examination or Birth Certificate from competent authority for verification of age.
- 13. Candidates will be required to take admission to the allotted Institution within 5 days from the date of allotment on payment of requisite fees to the respective Institution.
- 14. Besides the eligibility conditions prescribed by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board, a few Institutions prescribe some more eligibility conditions specific to those Institutes. The candidates must note those specific conditions before giving options to those Institutions.

- 15. Allotment by the Central Selection committee (Engineering & Technology) is entirely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria and other conditions specified in the Information Brochure of JELET-2010.
- 16. Counselling in terms of schedule shall continue till availability of seats. The counselling of a particular Branch of Engineering / Technological will be stopped instantly as soon as all seats in that Branch of Engineering/Technological are filled up. No further gueries in this regard will be entertained.
- 17. For B.Sc. candidates, allotment will be given to Self-financing Private Engineering Colleges only.
- 18. Candidates belonging to States other than West Bengal shall not be considered for admission to Govt. Engineering Colleges.
- 19. Any candidate appearing at the counselling with fake documents / testimonials will be handed over to the police instantly.
- 20. Any other important information related to the aforesaid counselling (if any) will be immediately communicated through the websites mentioned in SI No. 2.
