



Analysis of Cabinet Ministers of Goa (2012-2017)

Executive Summary

- National Election Watch (NEW) has analyzed the affidavits of all 5 newly appointed cabinet ministers and the Chief Minister, submitted to the Election Commission of India from the state of Goa.
- 50% ministers i.e. (3 out of 6 analyzed) have self declared criminal cases as per their affidavits filed during the recently concluded Assembly Elections.
- Among these 3 Ministers who have declared criminal cases against themselves, none of them have any serious criminal charges.
- Among these 3 Ministers who have declared criminal cases against themselves, 1)
 LAXMIKANT PARSEKAR (of BJP from Mandrem) has declared 1 case against himself including charges related to rioting, wrongful restraint etc., 2) FRANCIS D'SOUZA (of BJP from Mapusa) has declared 1 criminal case against himself including rioting, criminal intimidation and 3) DAYANAND MANDREKAR (of BJP from Siolim) has declared 1 criminal cases including charges of rioting, criminal intimidation etc.
- All 6 out of 6 or 100% Cabinet Ministers are crorepatis
- LAXMIKANT PARSEKAR of BJP from Mandrem has the highest assets (Rs. 10.74 Crores)
 among the Goa cabinet ministers followed by MATHANY SALDANHA of BJP from Cortalim
 constituency with assets worth Rs.7.65 Crores followed by RAMKRISHNA alias SUDIN
 DHAVALIKAR of MGP from Marcaim Constituency with assests worth Rs. 5.58 Crores among
 the Goa cabinet ministers.
- The average asset of a minister in Goa comes out to be 5.53 crores.
- **DAYANAND MANDREKAR** of BJP from Siolim with assets worth 2.63 Crores, has the lowest assets among all the ministers analyzed in Goa.
- Among all the 6 ministers analyzed, none of them is woman.

Background

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. National Election Watch (NEW) has analyzed the affidavits of 6 cabinet ministers in Goa.

This report is based on the analysis of these affidavits. The following pages give analysis of criminal, financial and other background information of the Ministers.





Analysis Based on Declared Criminal Cases against Ministers

- 50% ministers i.e. (3 out of 6 analyzed) have self declared criminal cases as per their affidavits filed during the recently concluded Assembly Elections.
