5. Discuss Shaw's 'Saint Joan' as an Allegorical play. 16
6. Discuss the nature of tragedy in the Playboy of the Western World'. 16

7. The ending of the play 'Look Back in Anger' has been considered unsatisfactory. Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer. 16

8. Is it true that Lawrence presents a tangle of personal relationships in 'Sons and Lovers'? Give reasons for your answer. 16

Compare and contrast Stephen's perception of art with his perception of religion, family and country in 'A Portrait of an Artist as a Young Man'. 16

9. Discuss 'threat of oppression' and 'fear of death' as major themes of 'Mrs. Dalloway'. 16

Or

What is the role played by 'memory' in the play 'Waiting for Godot'. 16

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
